

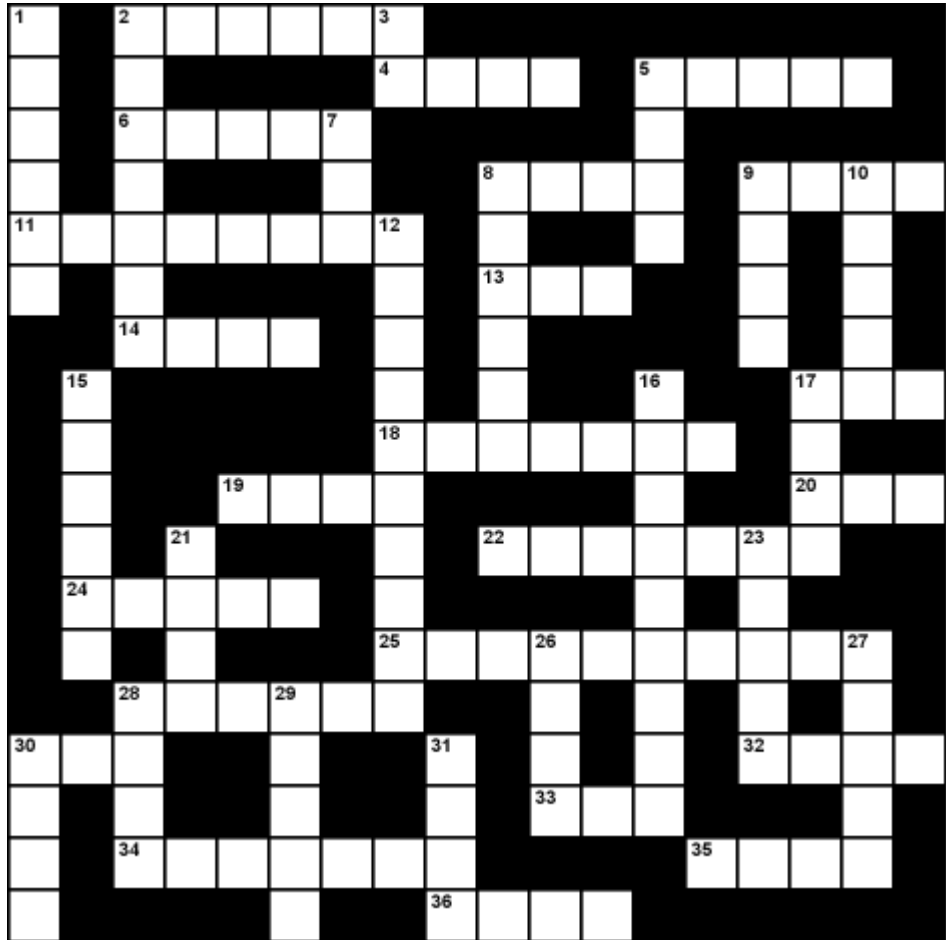
## A11c Love Your Enemies, Matthew 5:38-48 Seventh Sunday in Lent
