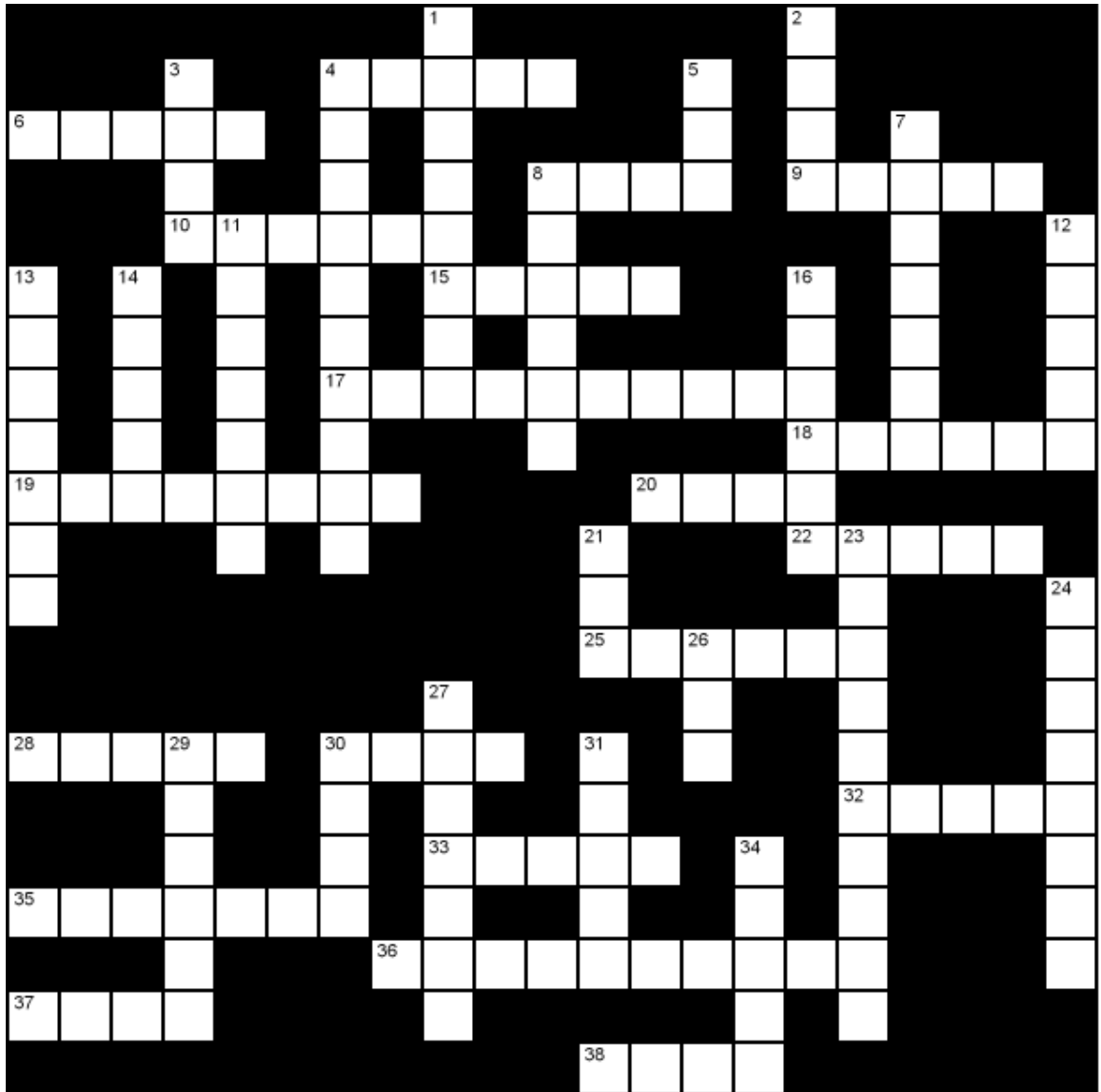


A12 Jesus Says No to the Tempter, Matthew 4:1-11, First Sunday in Lent
