

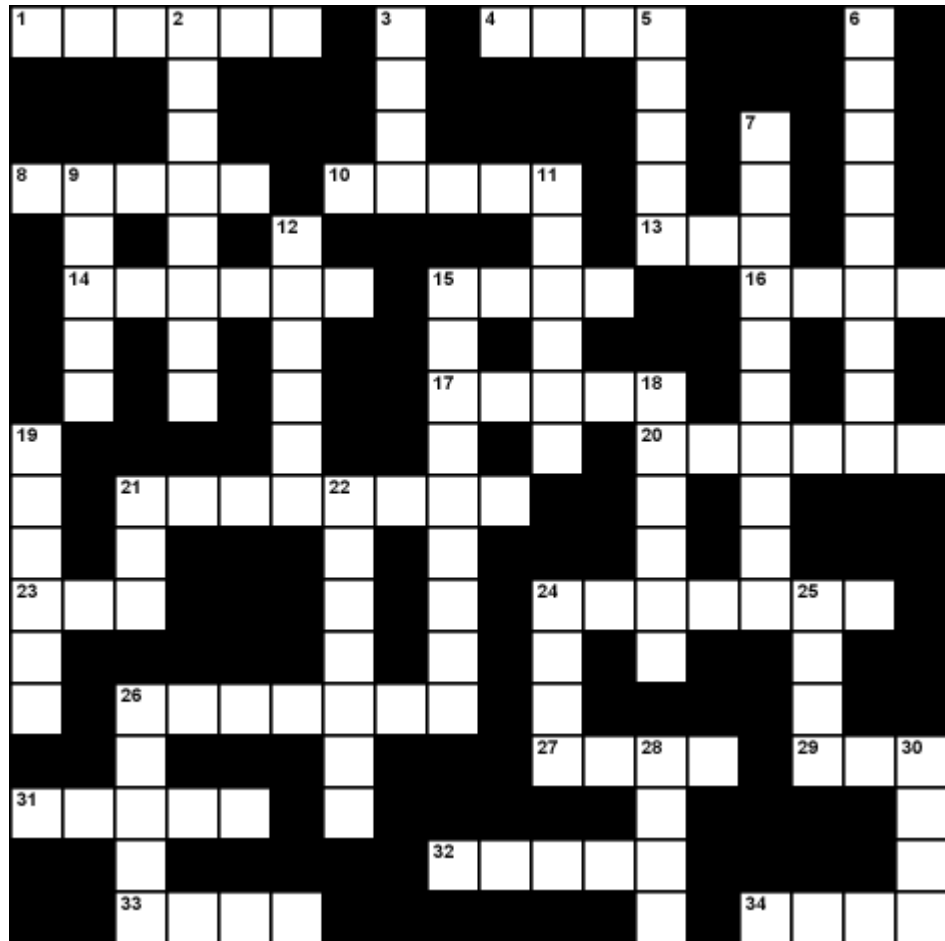
A13 Jesus Becomes Dazzling White, Matthew 17:1-9
