

A15 Blind Man Sees, John 9:1-41, Fourth Sunday in Lent

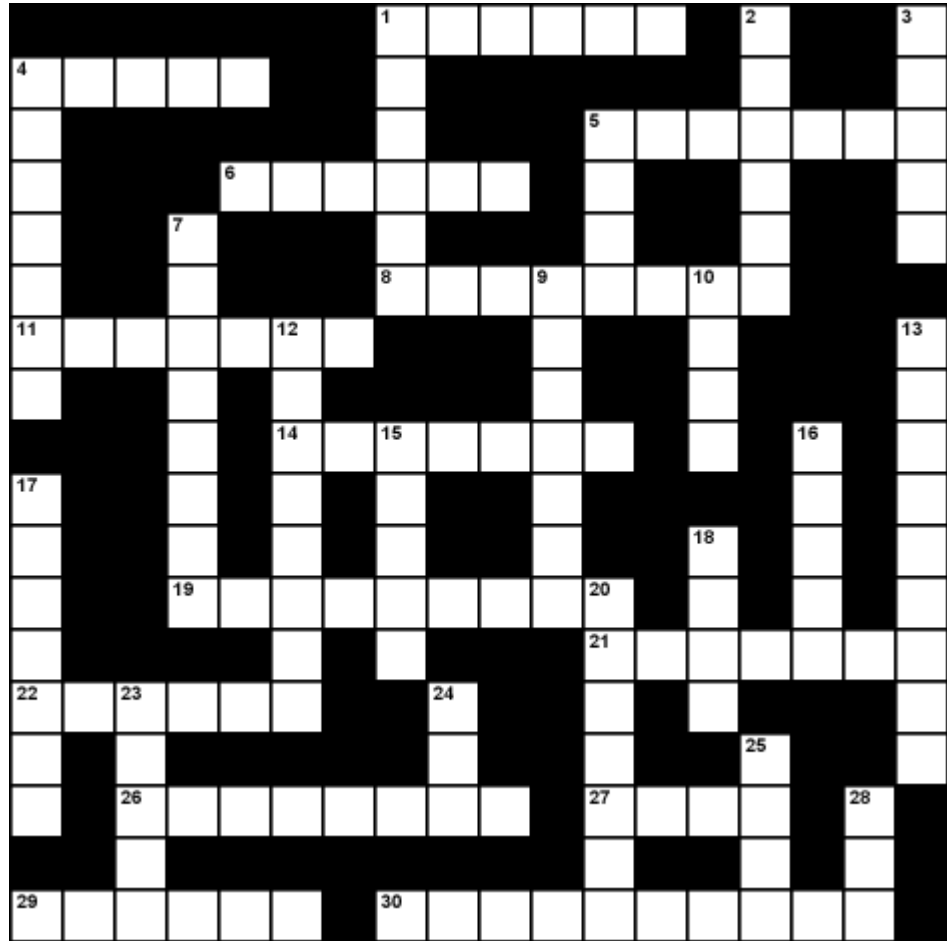
