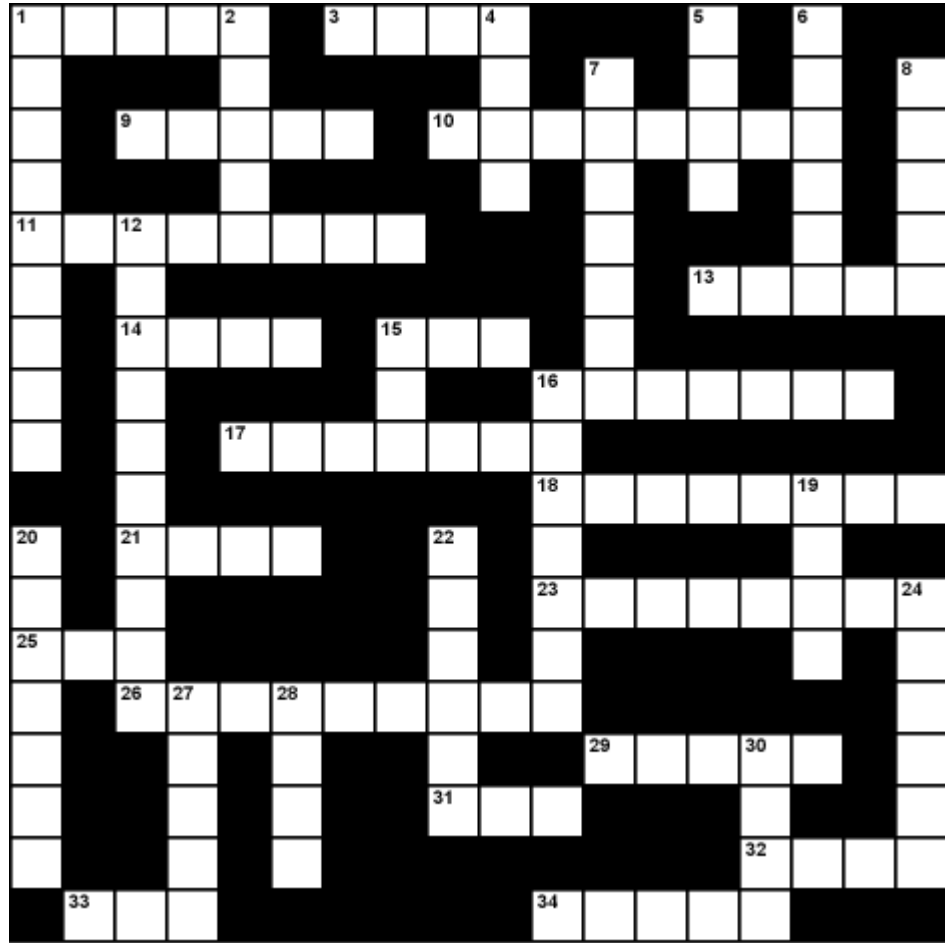


A16 Lazarus, Come Out, John 11:1-7, 17-45, Fifth Sunday in Lent
