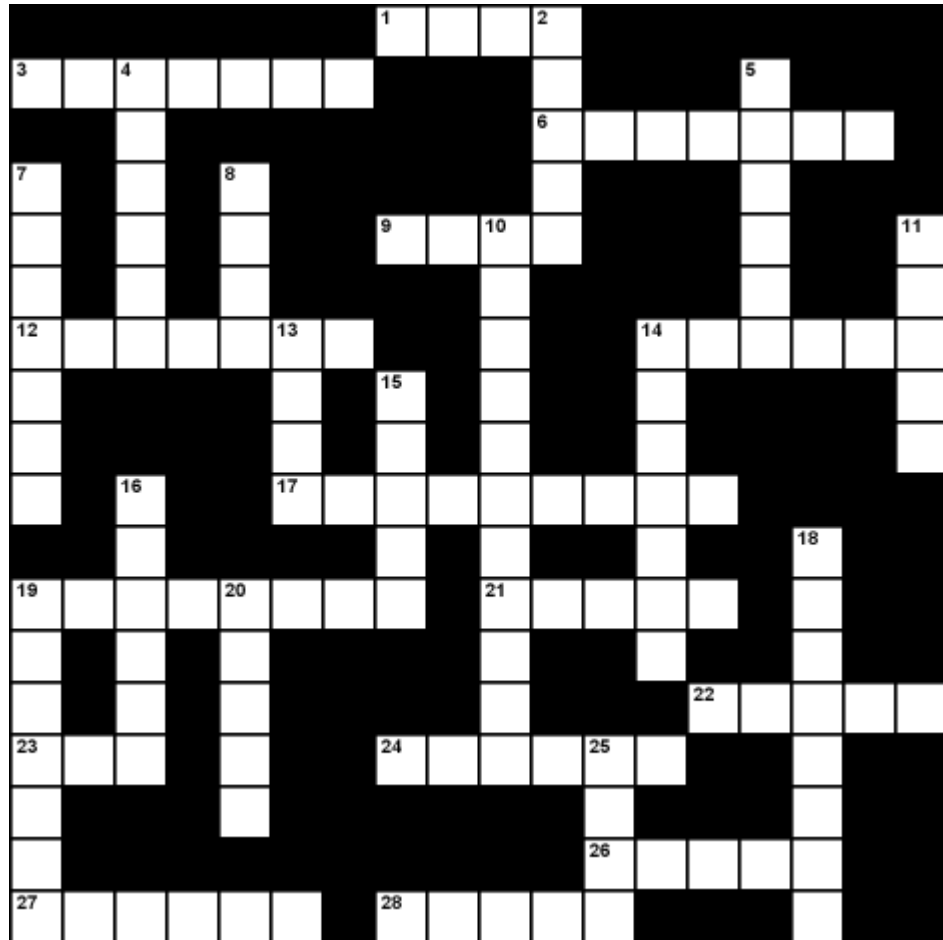


A17 Branches of Honor, Matthew 21:1-11, 26:14-75; 27:1-66, Passion/Palm Sunday

Do not praise your friend one minute, and become his enemy the next. One minute people liked Jesus because he was powerful. He healed them. He forgave them their sins. Then everything went berserk. The rulers and the people got jealous and scared of Jesus and his power. The crowds turned against Jesus and demanded he be crucified. If things go haywire between you and your friend, remember to forgive him. Ask him to forgive you. If you are jealous, remember that you have strengths, too. Do the loving thing, pray for him and for yourself. Ask God to help you love enough to live in peace. Jesus is inside you and your friends. If you hurt your friend, you hurt Jesus, too.
