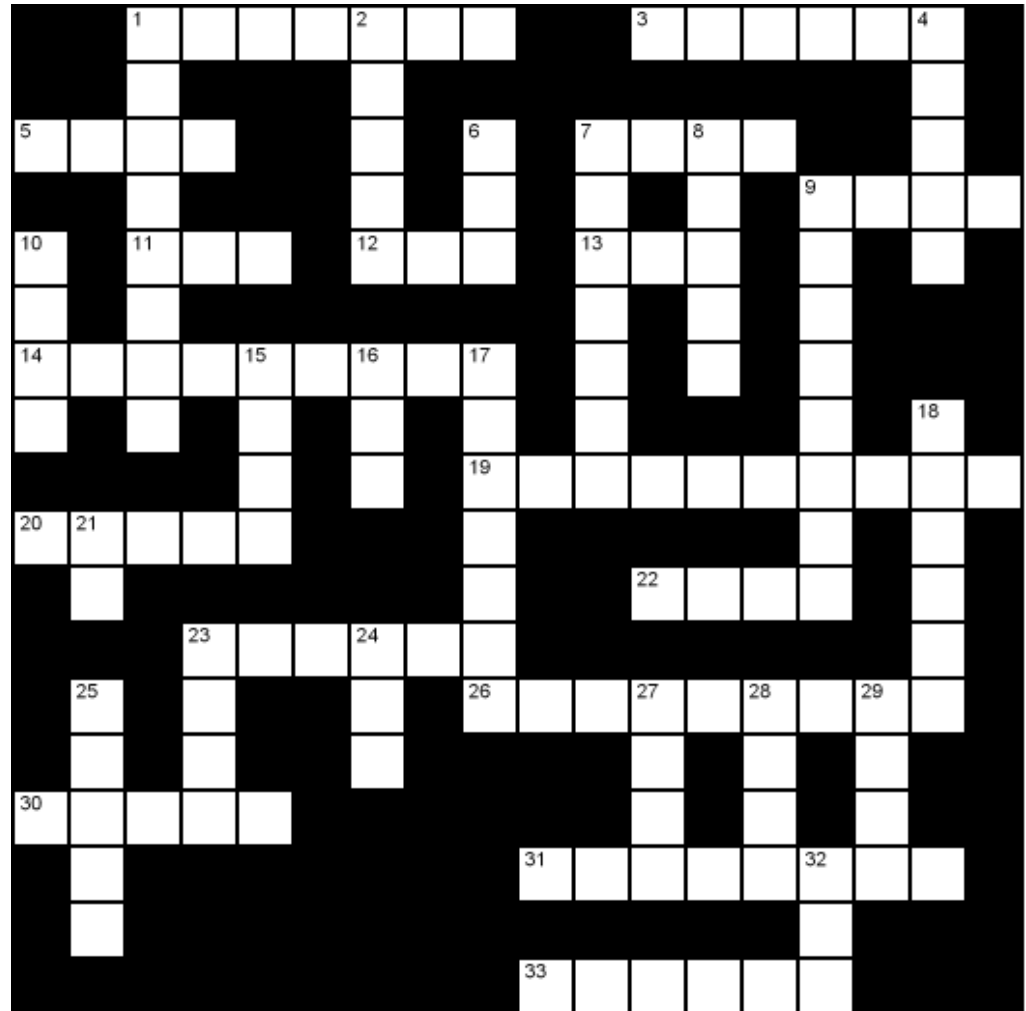


## A27a Do the Will of My Father in Heaven, Matthew 7:21-27, Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time
