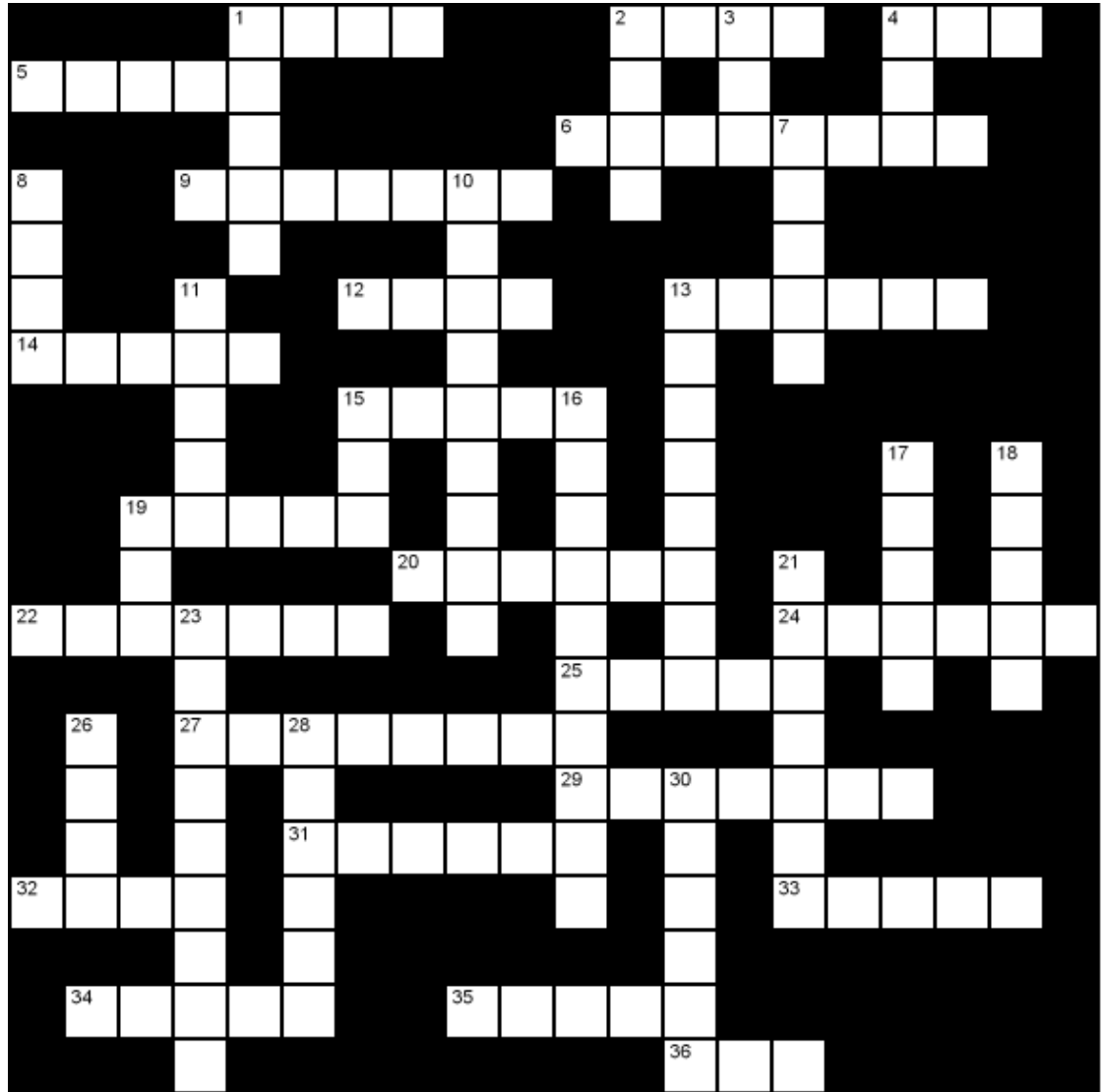


A34 Gather the Wheat, Matthew 13:24-43, Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
