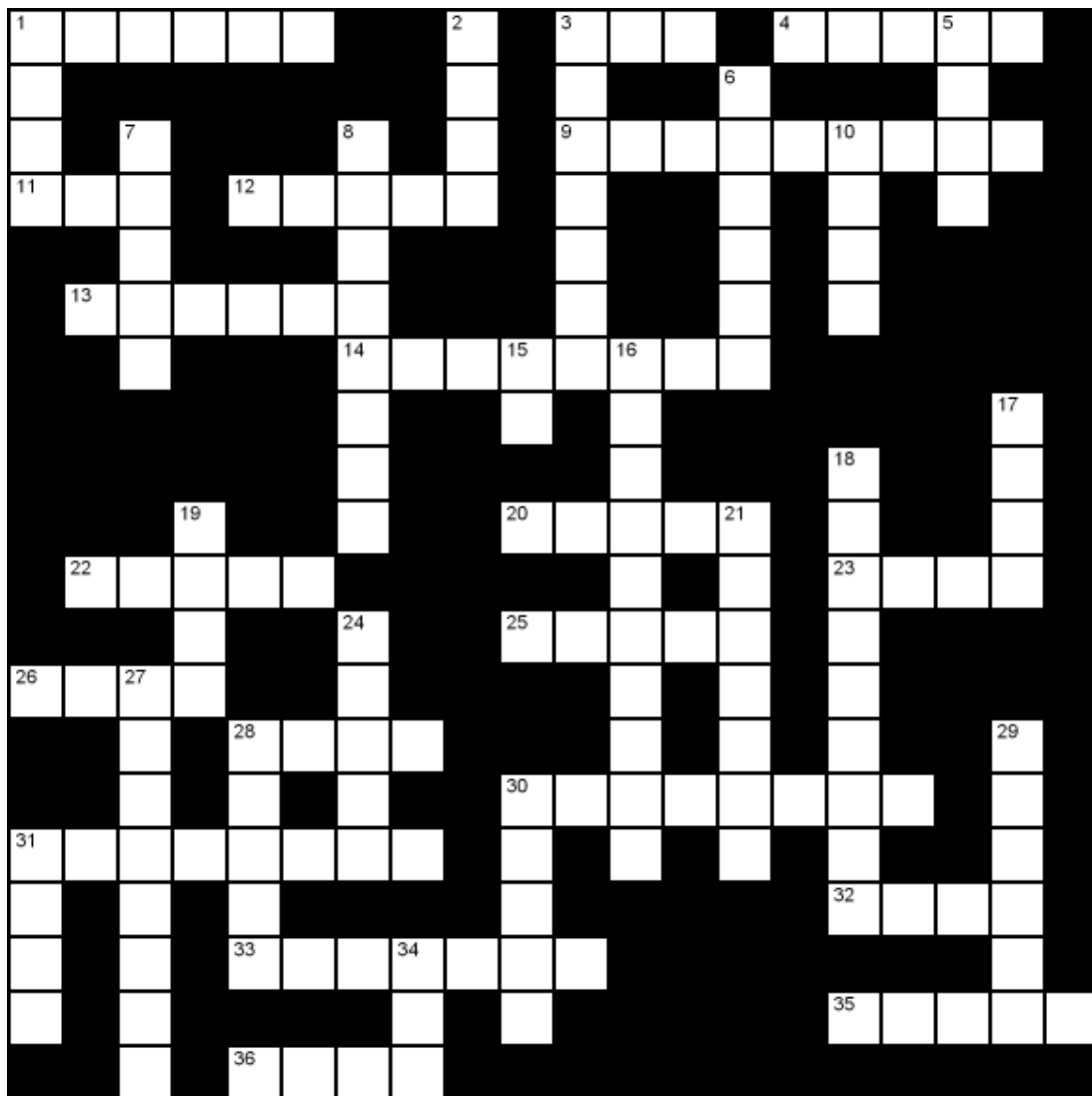


**A36 Five Loaves and Two Fish, Matthew 14:13-21,
