

A38 Lord Help Me, Matthew 15:21-28, Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

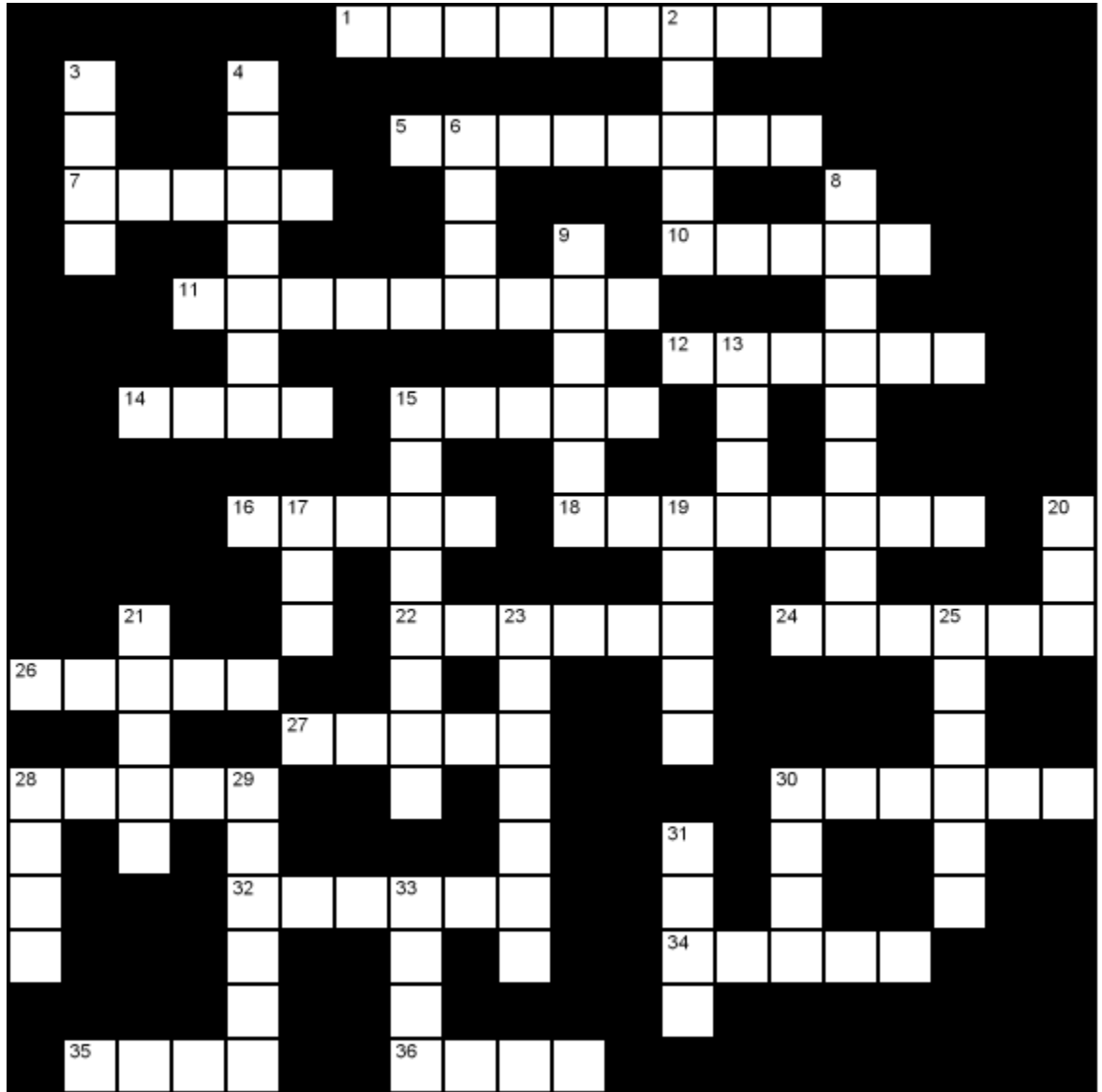
