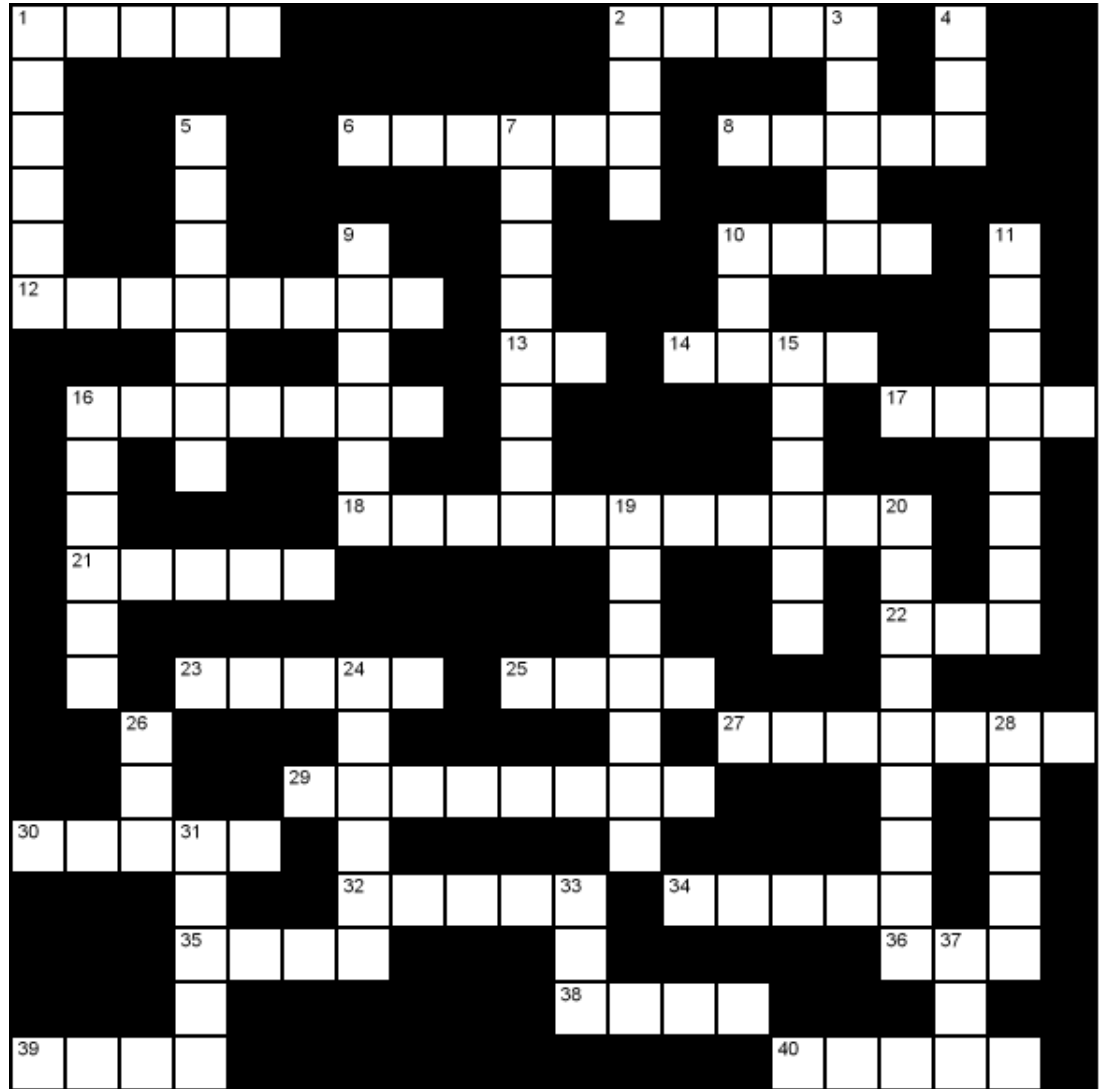


A39 You Are Peter, Matthew 16:13-20, Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time
