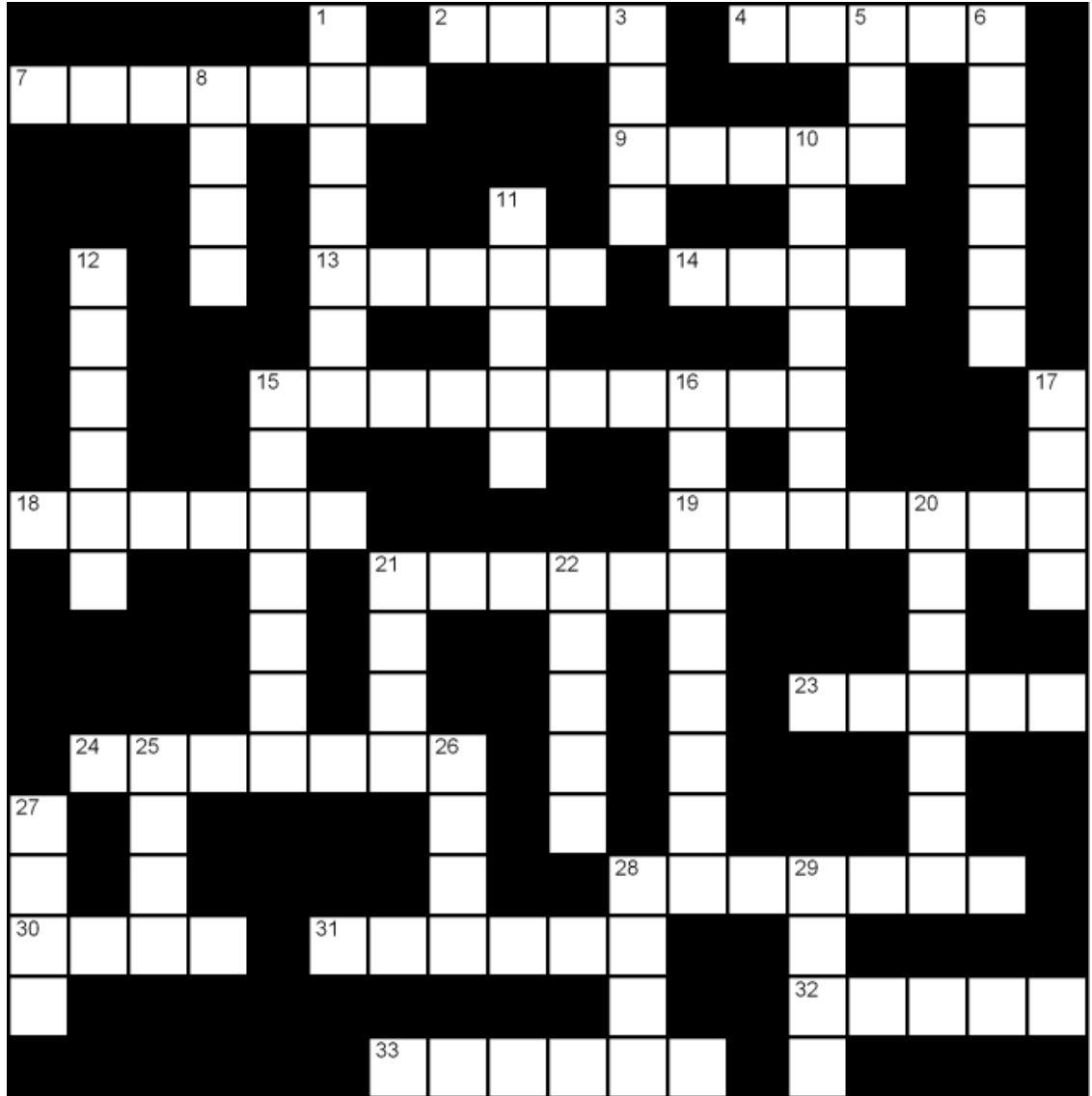


A3 The Deaf Hear, Matthew 11: 2-11, Third Sunday in Advent

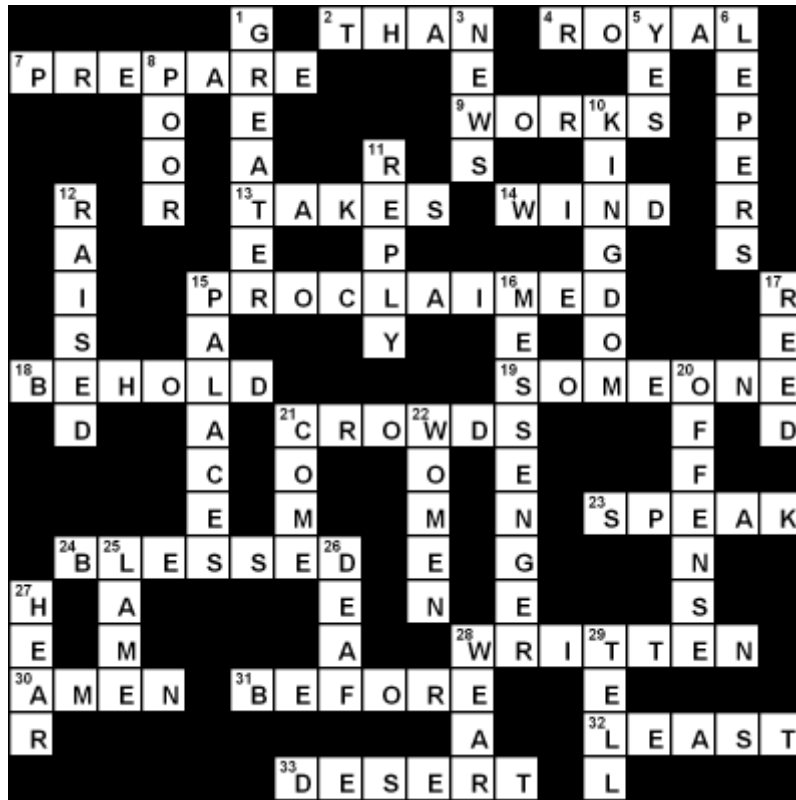
