

A40 Jesus Must Be Killed, Matthew 16:21-27 Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

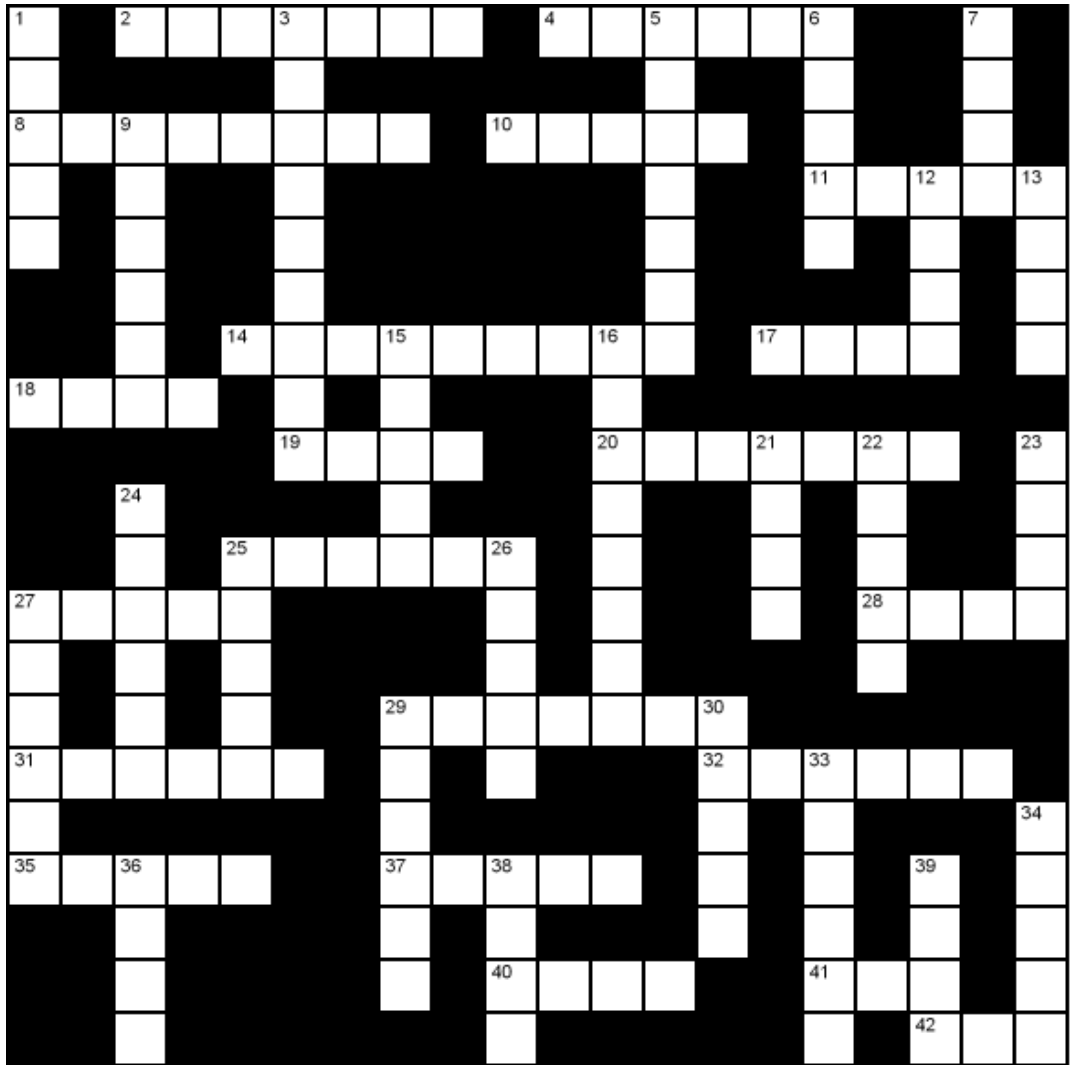
