

A42a God So Loved the World, John 3:13-17, Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross

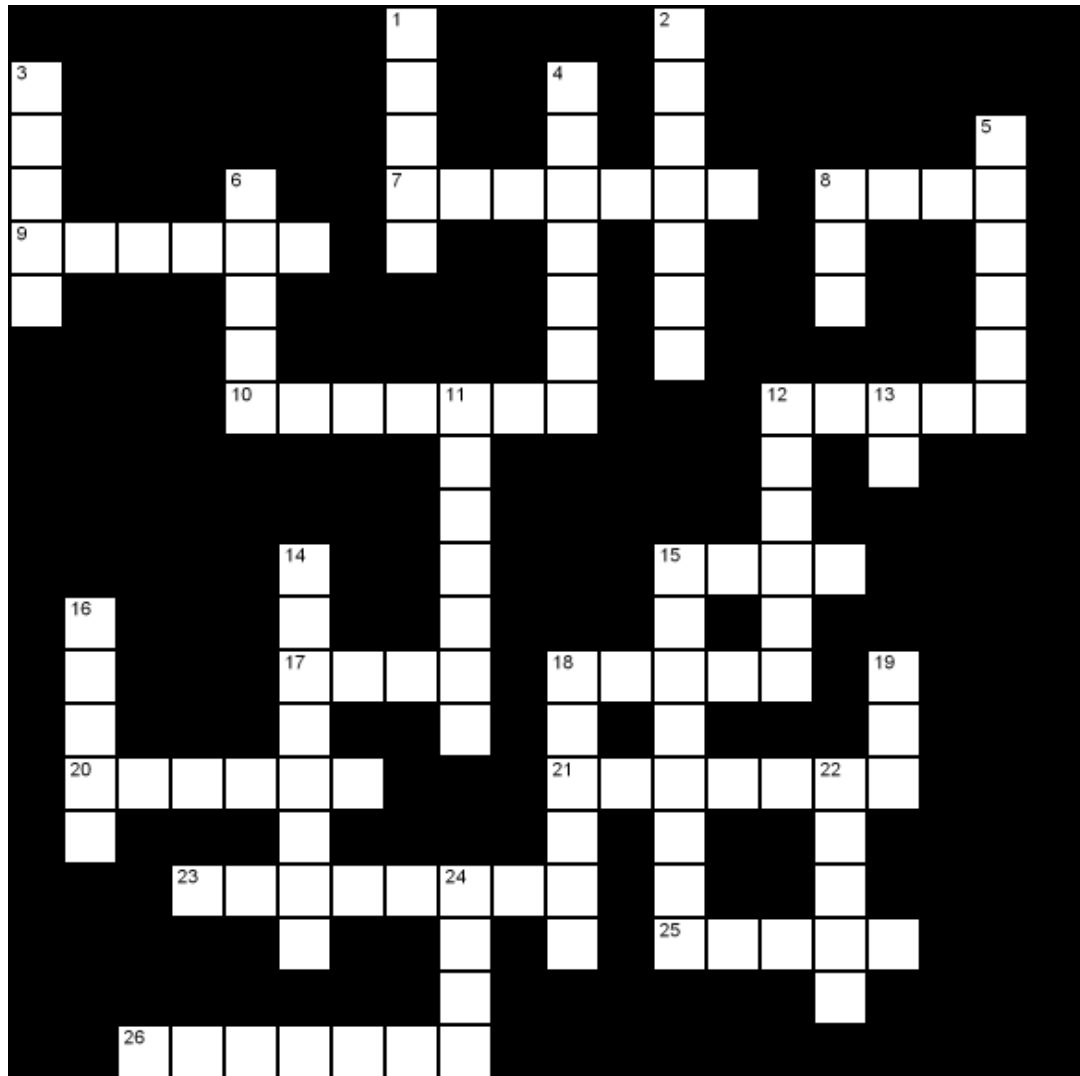
