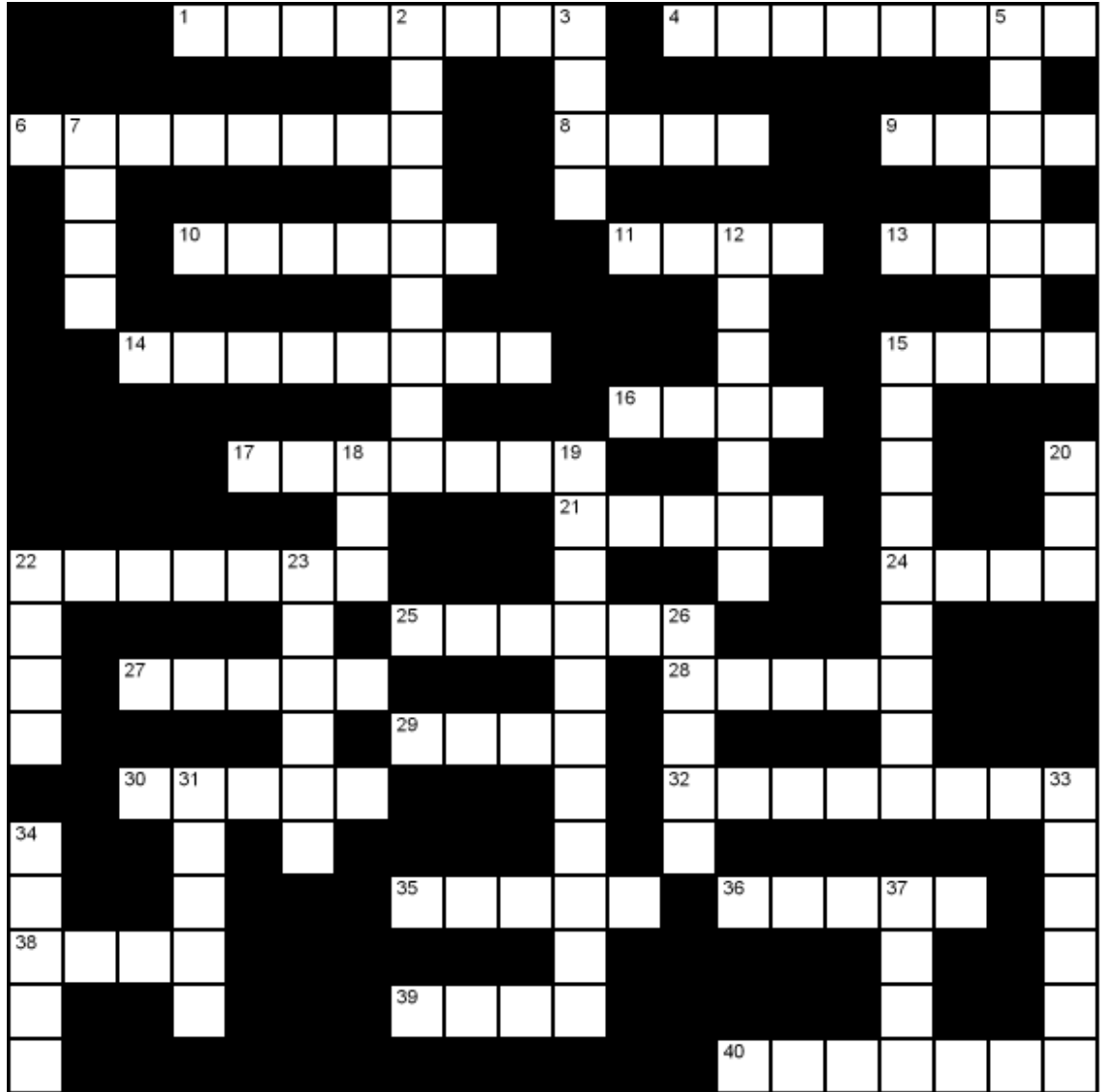


## A43 The Last Will Be First, Matthew 20:1-16, Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
