God tells you to do something, and you say, "NO, I don't want to."

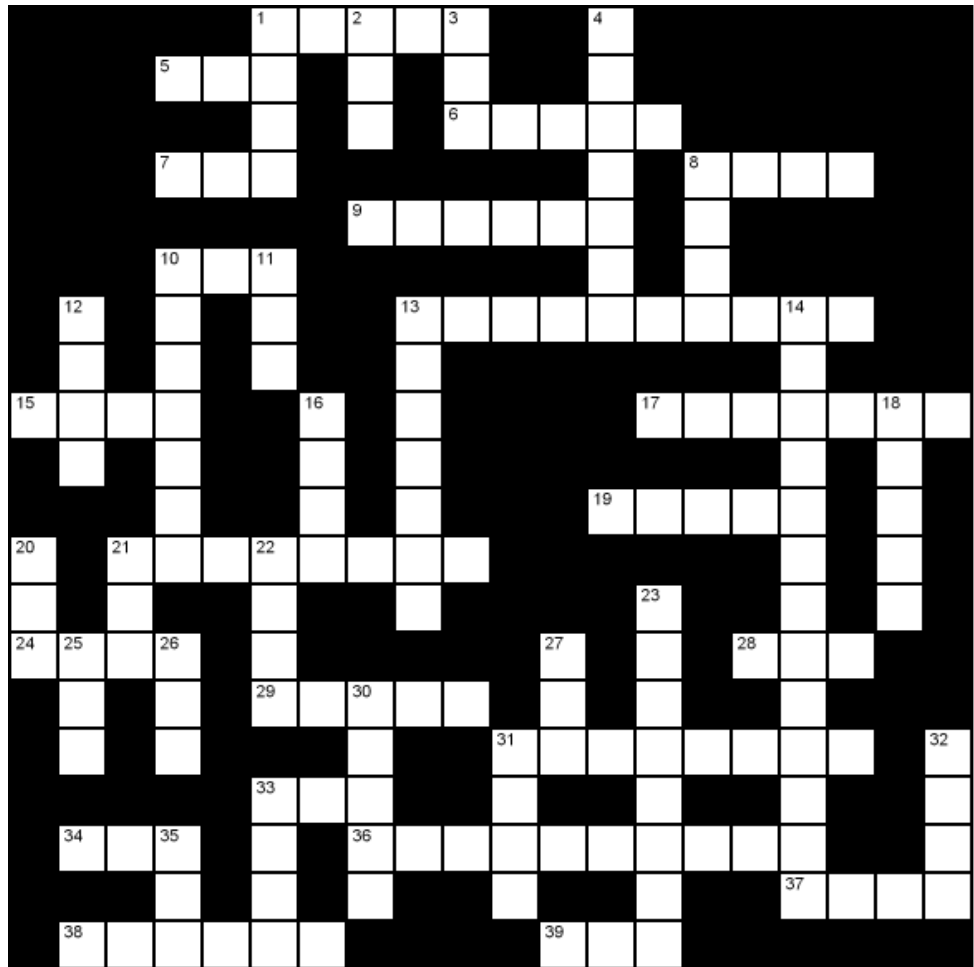
That makes God very sad. Your father asks you to clean up your toys. You tell him, "No, I don't want to."
