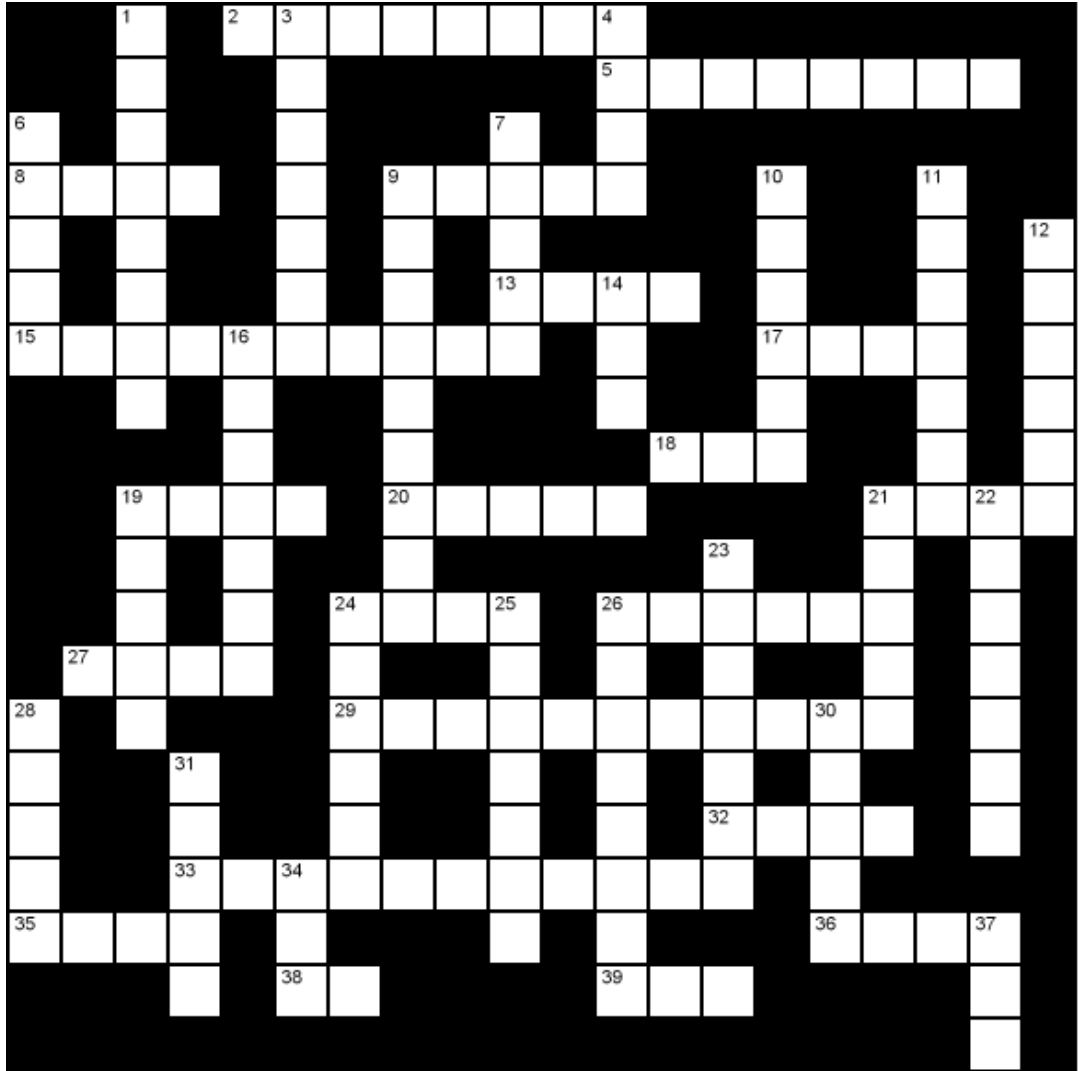


## A45 They Will Respect My Son, Matthew 21:33-43, Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
