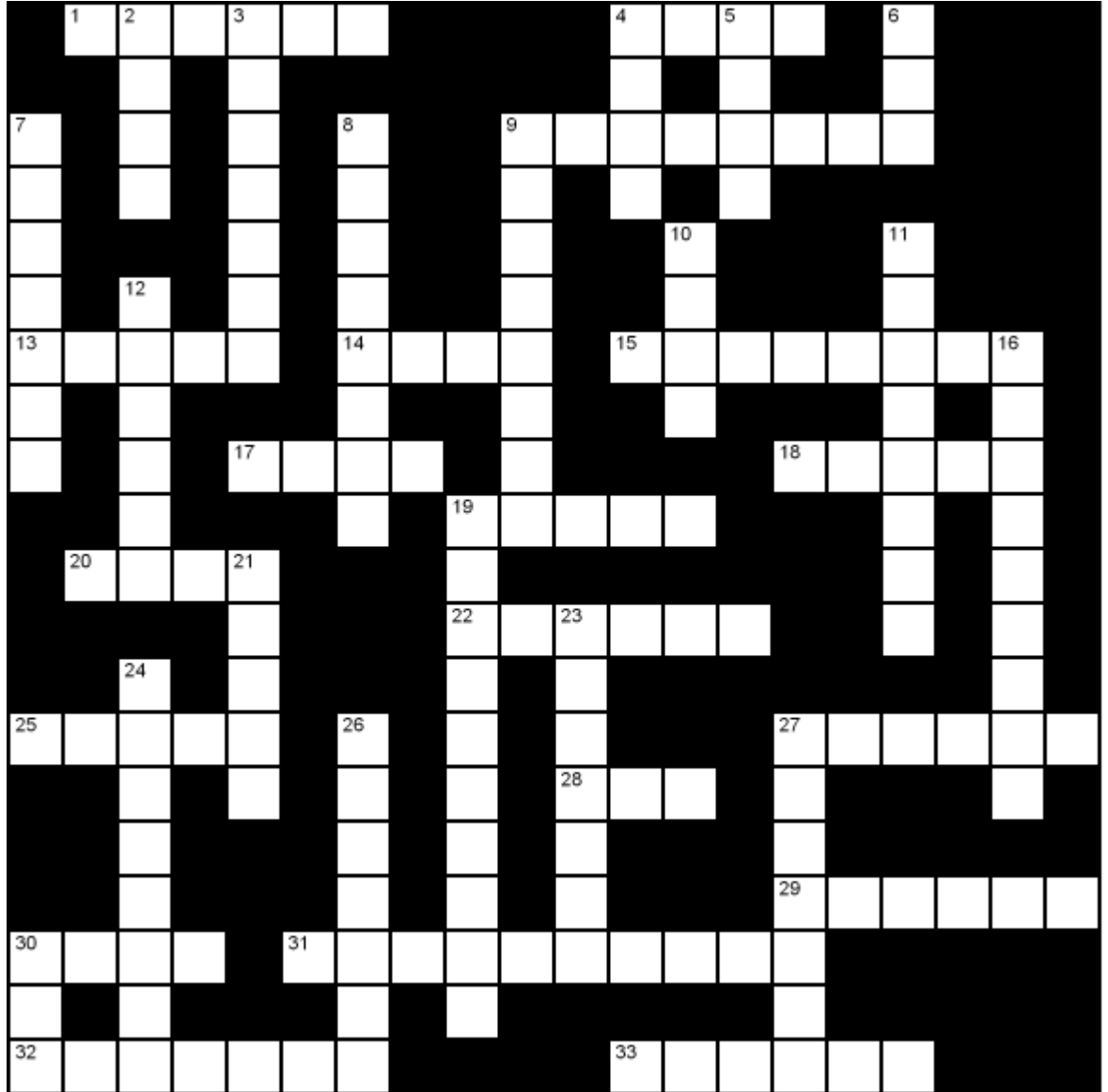


A46 Come to My Wedding Feast, Matthew 22:1-14 Twenty- Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time
