

A47 Pay to Caesar, Matthew 22:15-21, Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

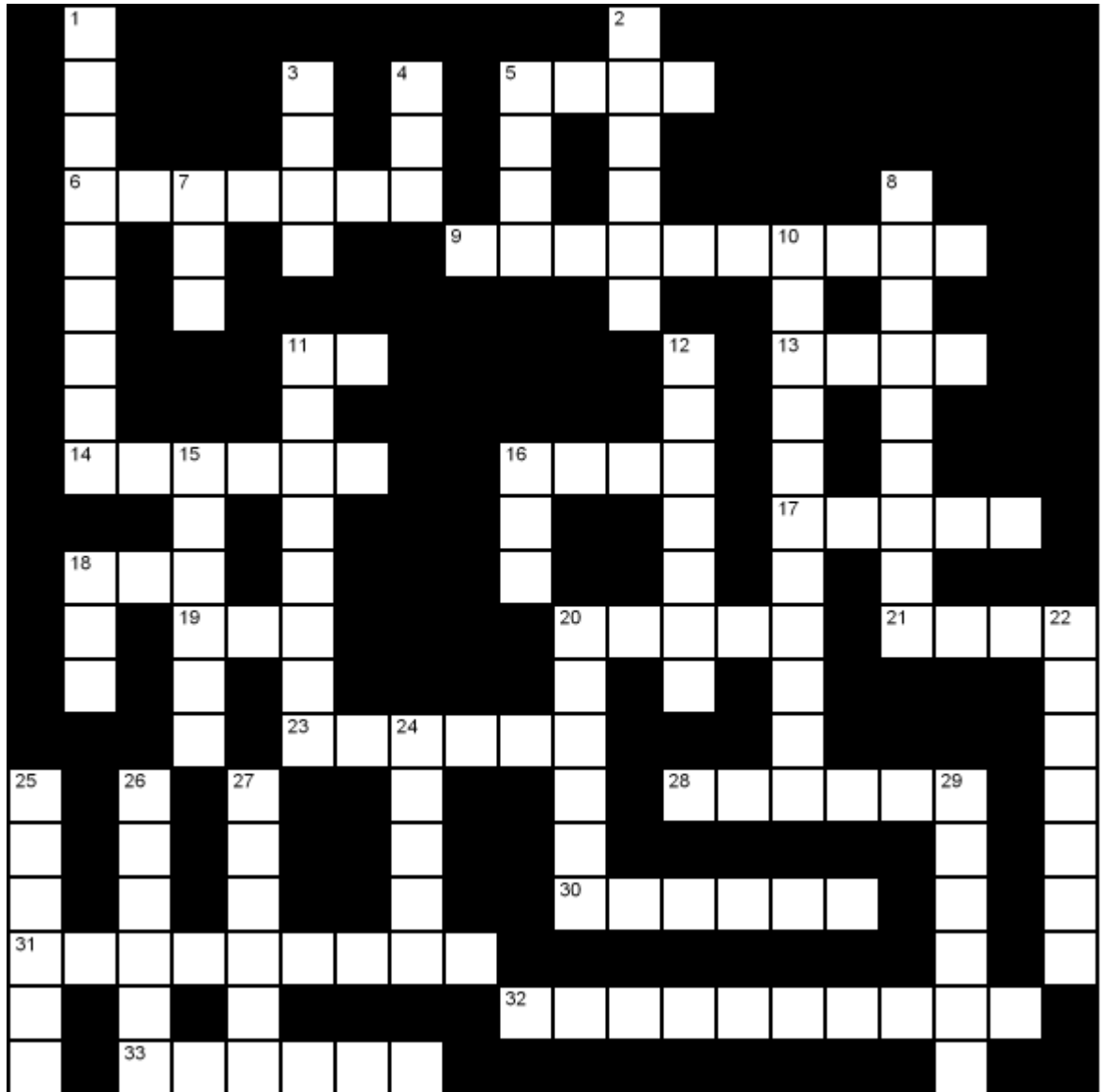
