

A50 Ten Virgins with Lamps and Oil, Matthew 25:1-13 Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

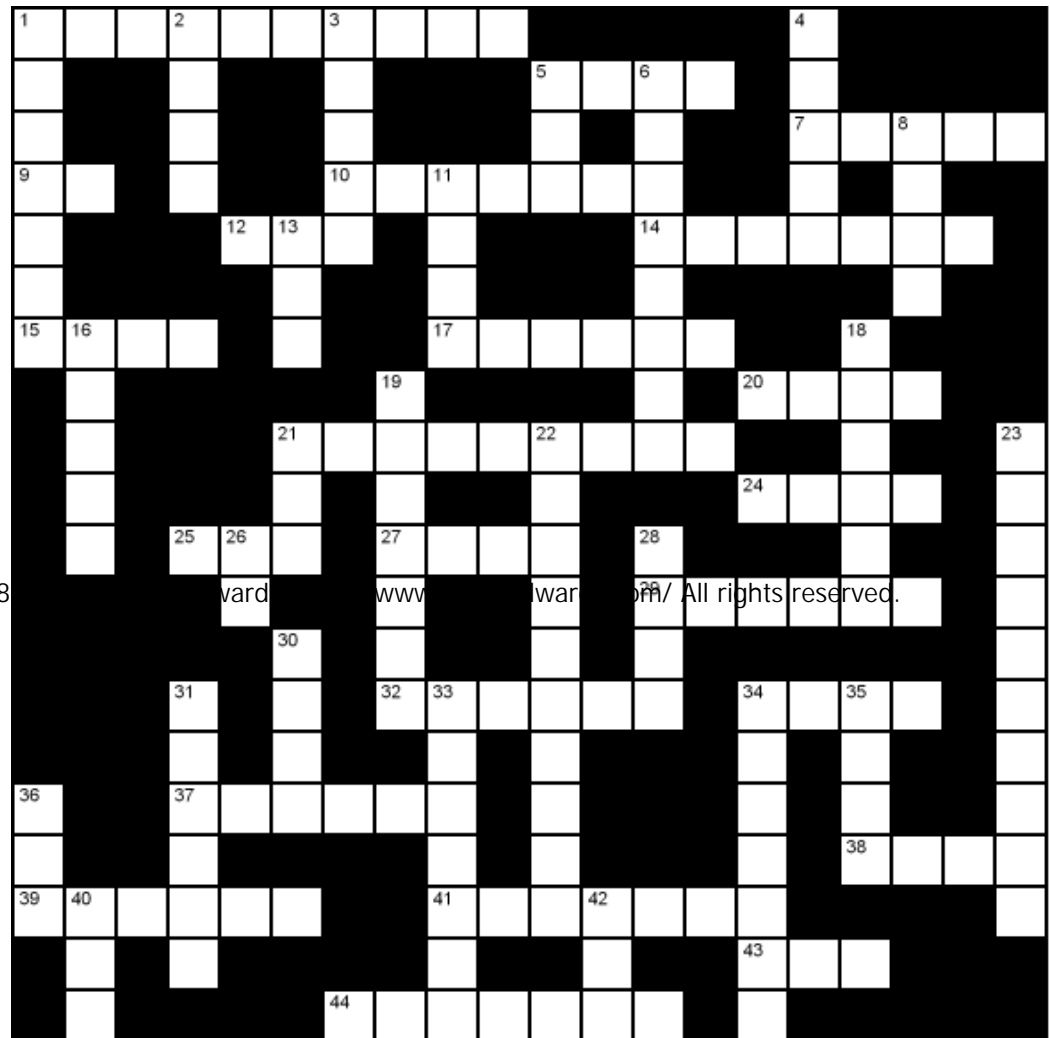
