

## A51 Ten Talents, Matthew 25:14-30, Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

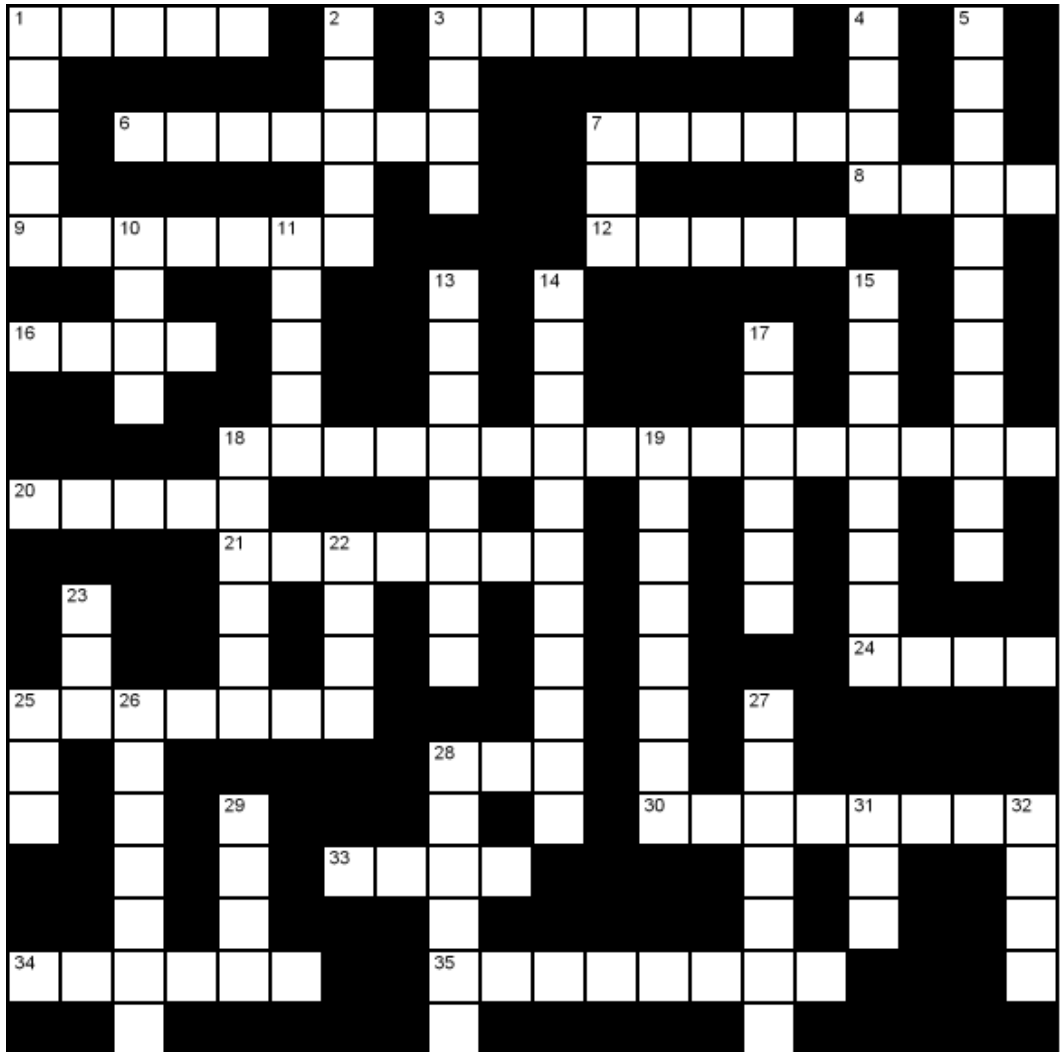
