

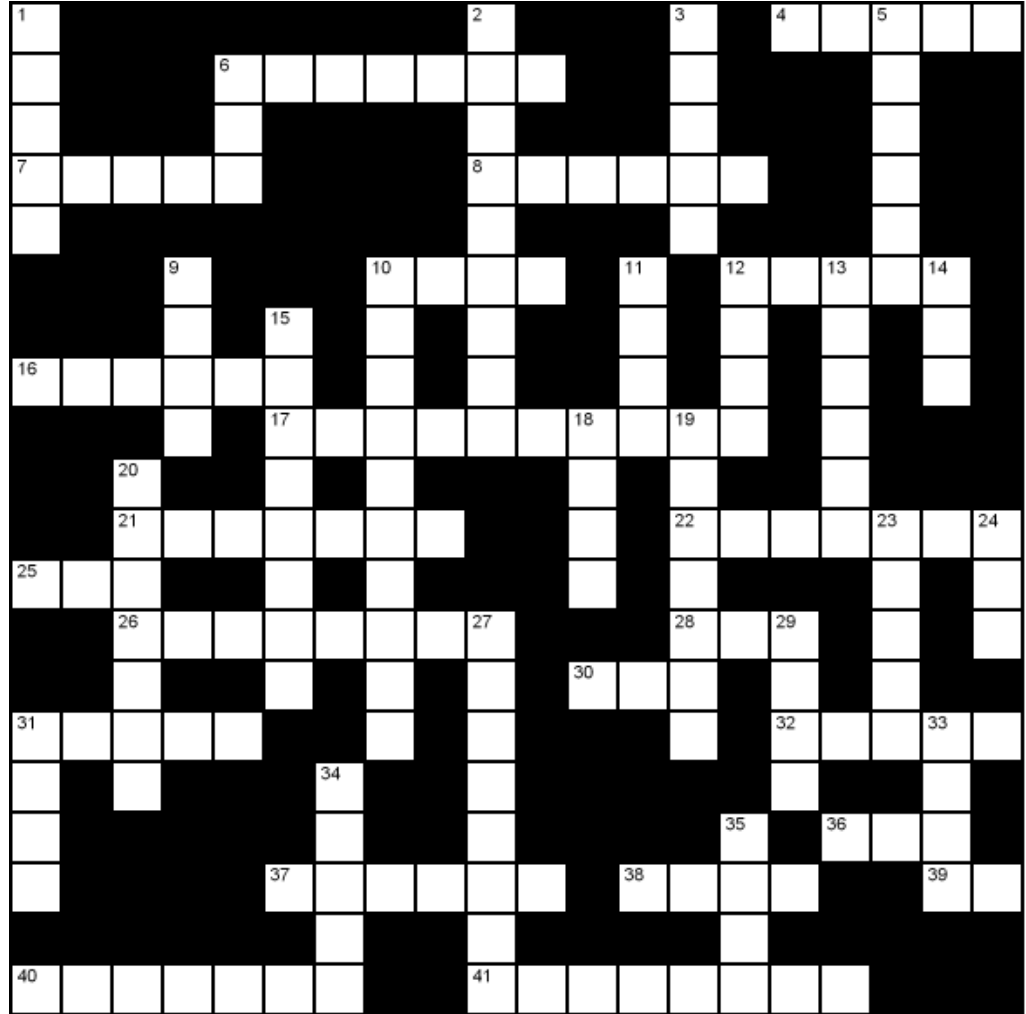
A52 What You Do to the Least, Matthew 25:31-46
