

B11 Driving Out Demons, Mark 1:29-39, Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

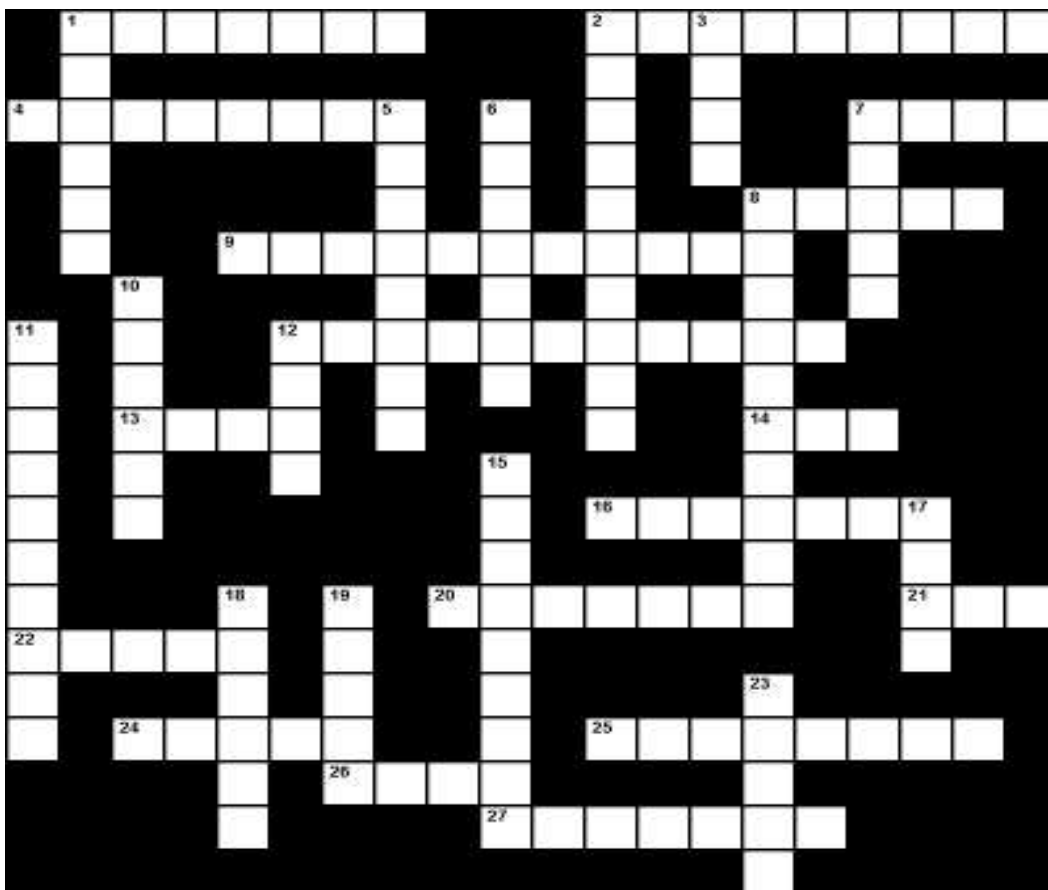
