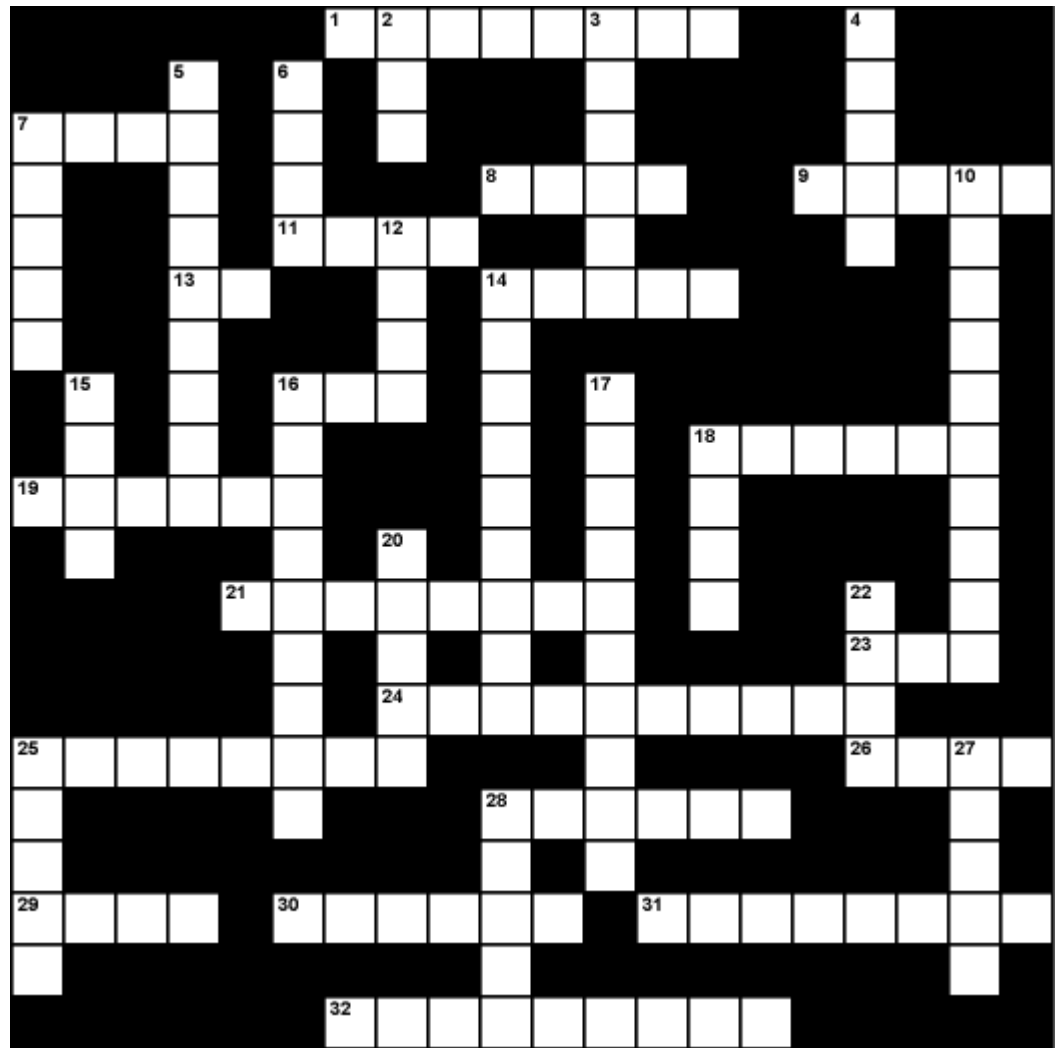


## B13a Fasting, Mark 2:18-22, Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time
