

B13b Don't Blow a Trumpet before You, Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18, Ash Wednesday

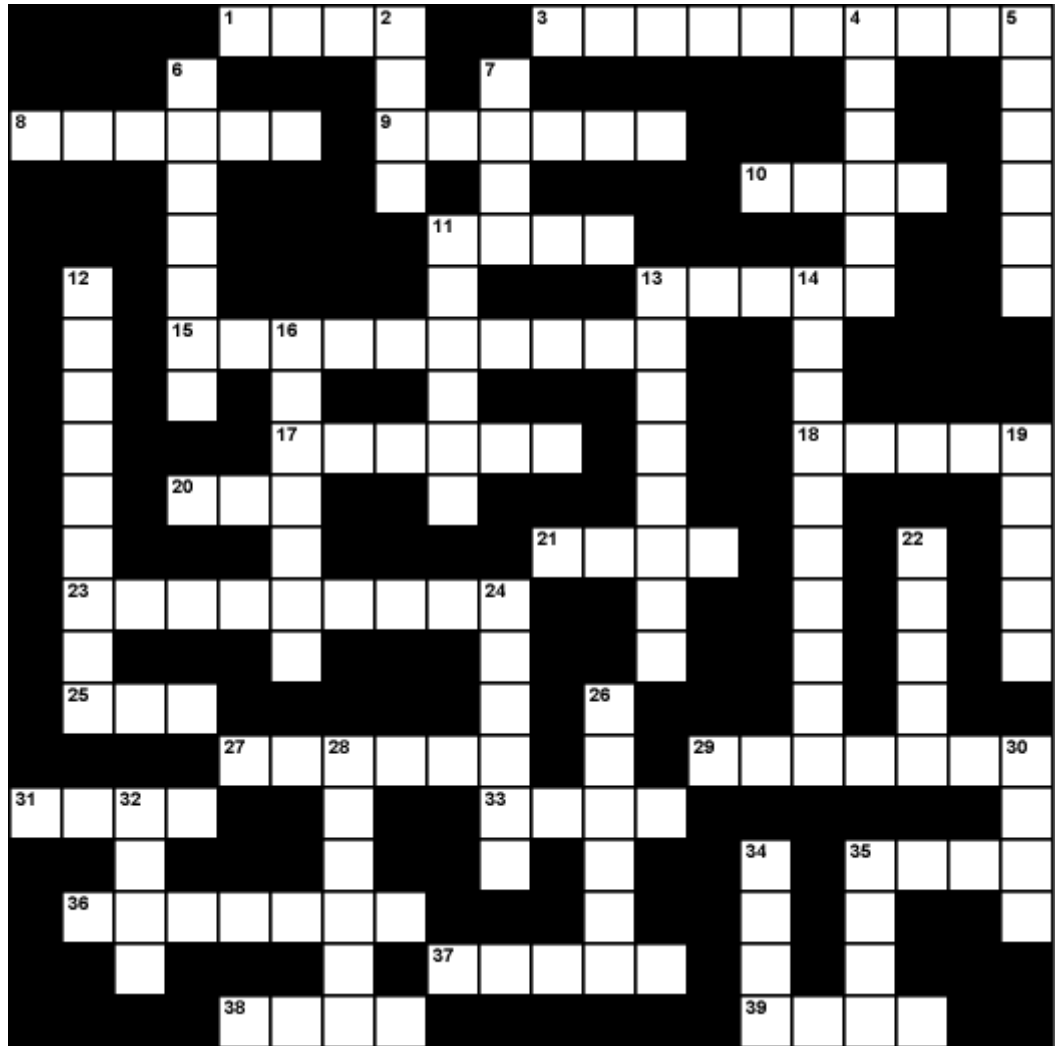
