

## B14 Repent and Believe, Mark 1:12-15, First Sunday in Advent

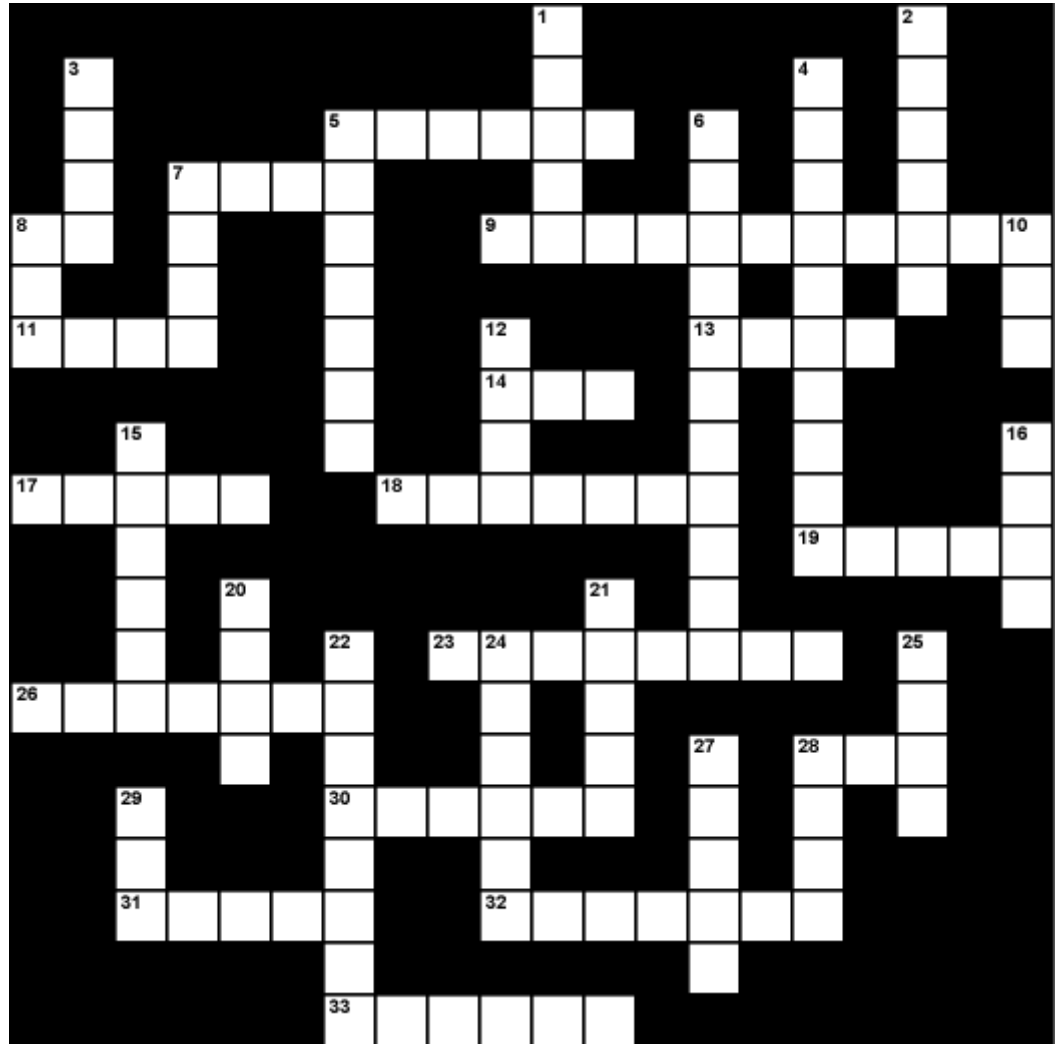
