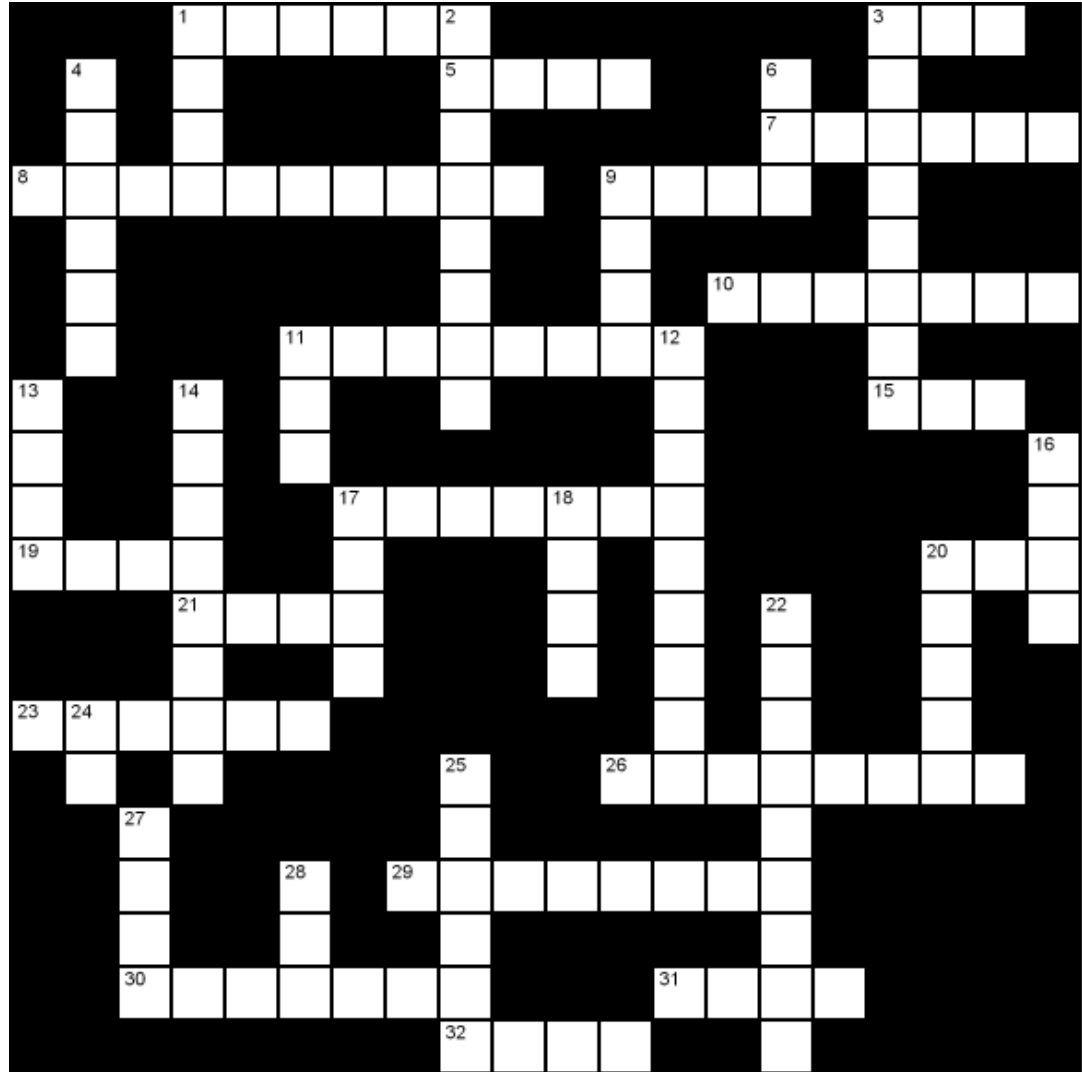


B1 Be Alert, Matthew 13:13-37, First Sunday in Advent
