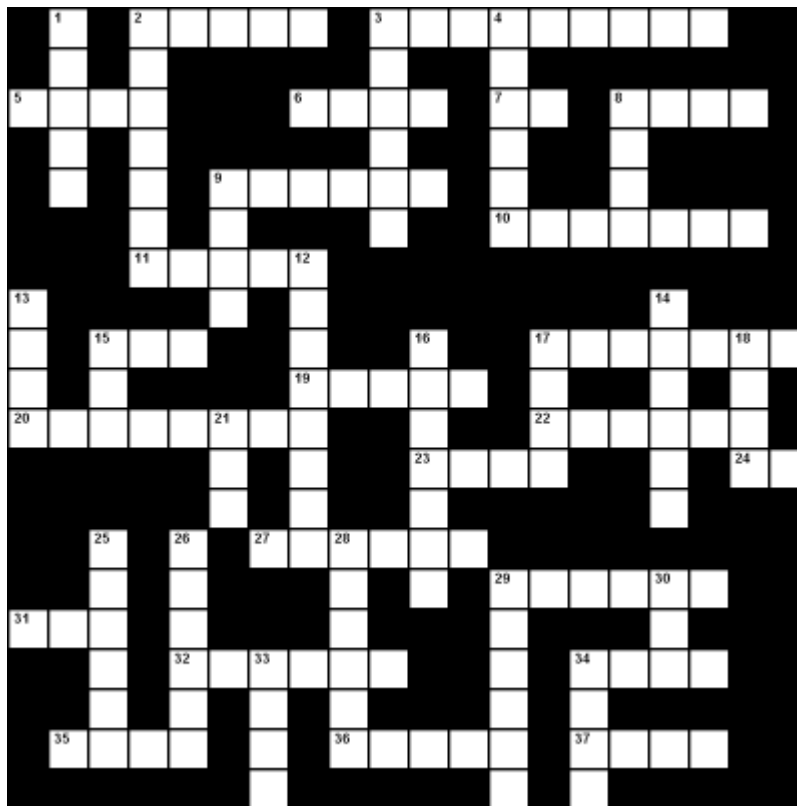


B24 I Am the Vine, John 15:1-8, Fifth Sunday of Easter
