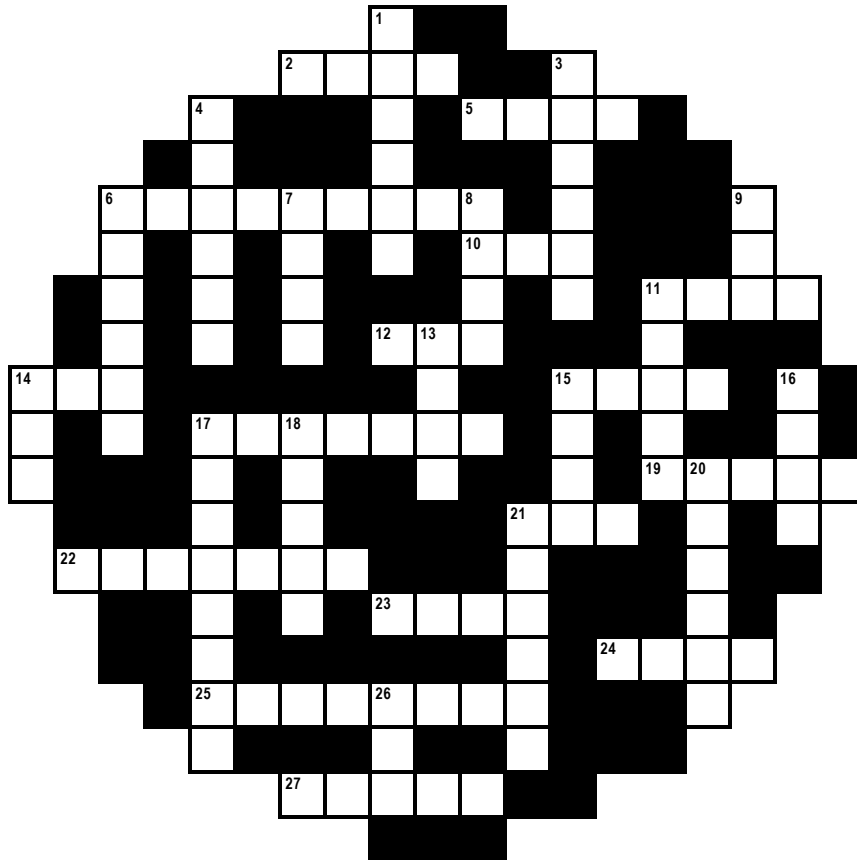


B25 Love One Another, John 15:9-17, Sixth Sunday of Easter
