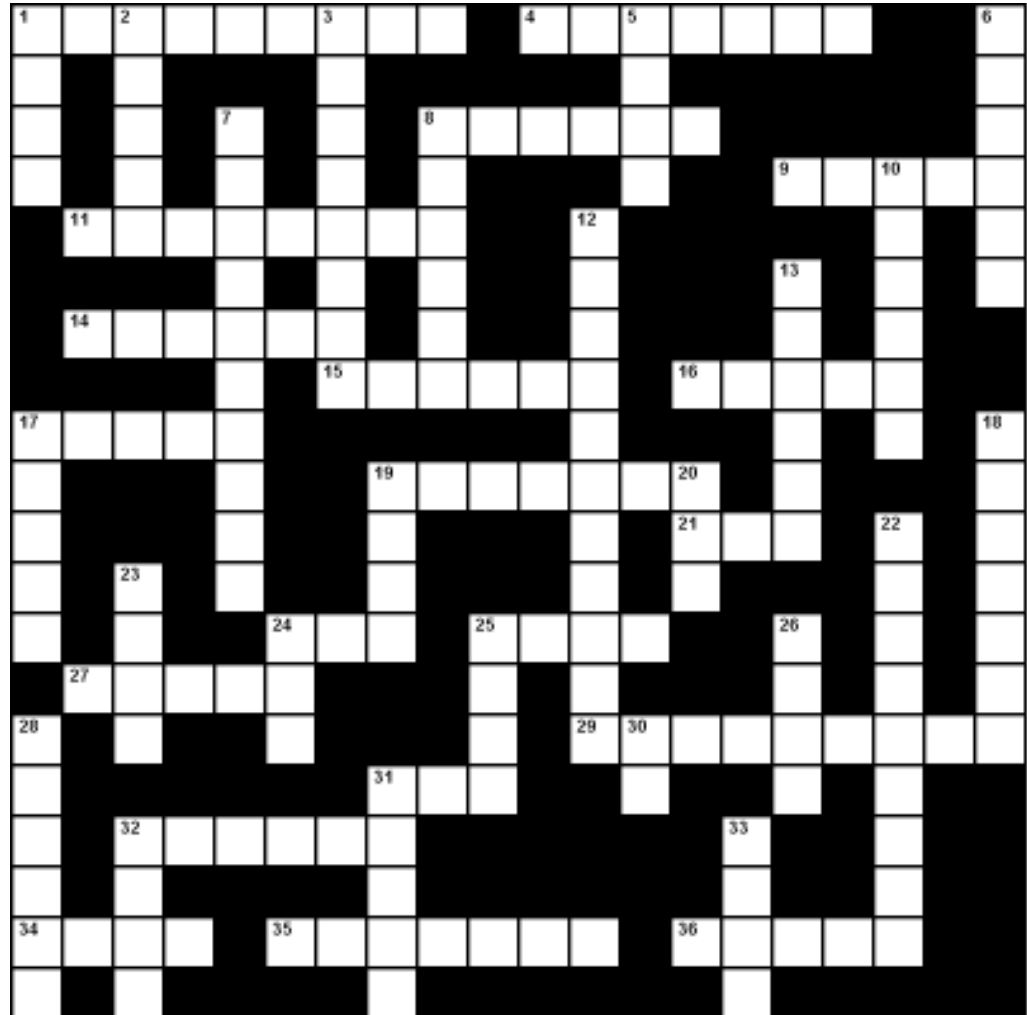


B28a All Sins and All Blasphemies, Mark 3:20-35, Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
