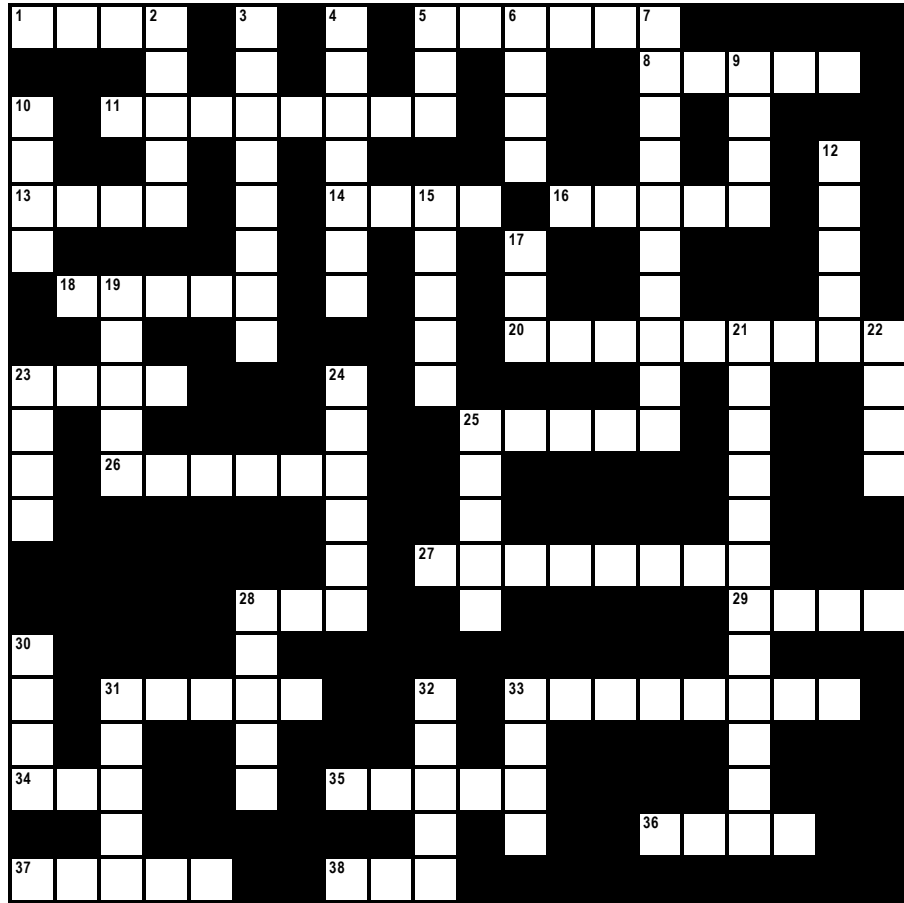


**B29 Bread and Wine, Body and Blood, Mark 14:12-16, 22-26,
