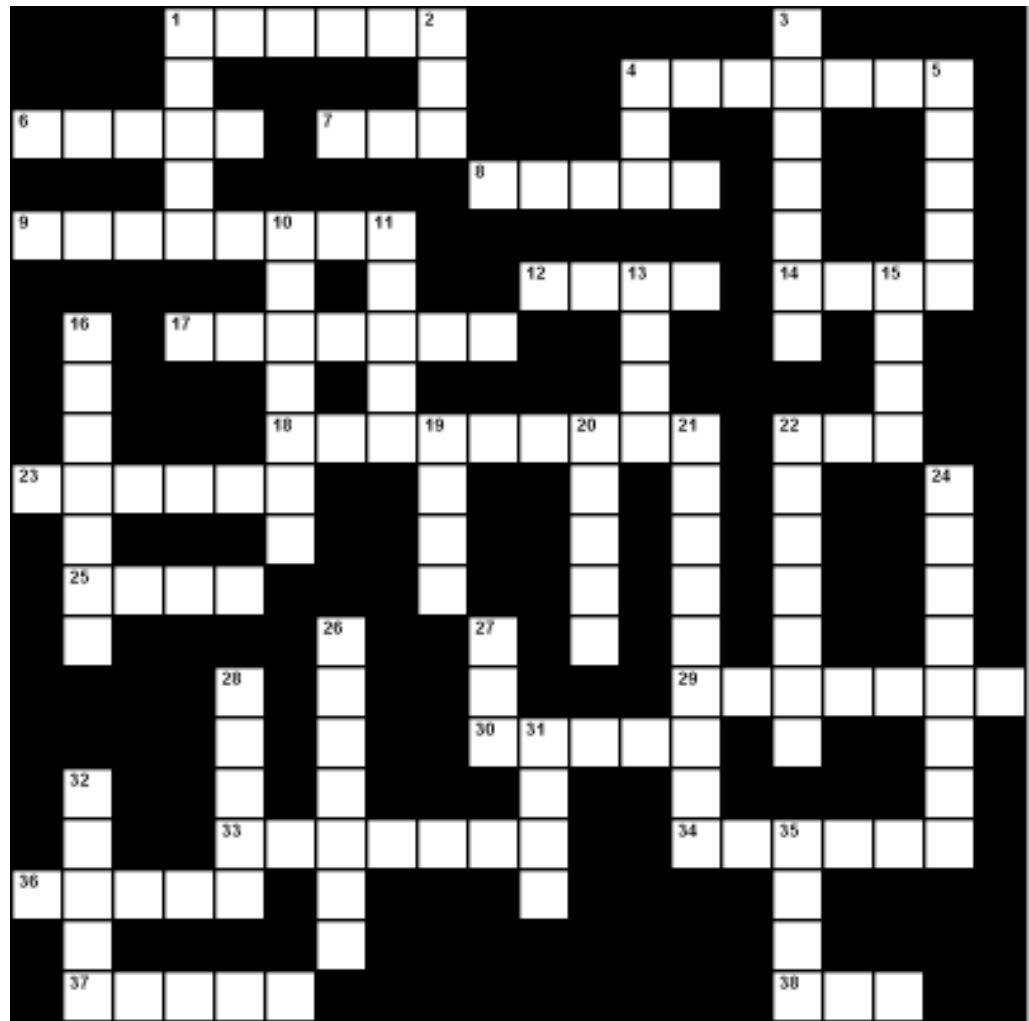


**B29a Like a Mustard Seed, Mark 4:26-34,
