

B31 Faith Heals, Mark 5:21-43, Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

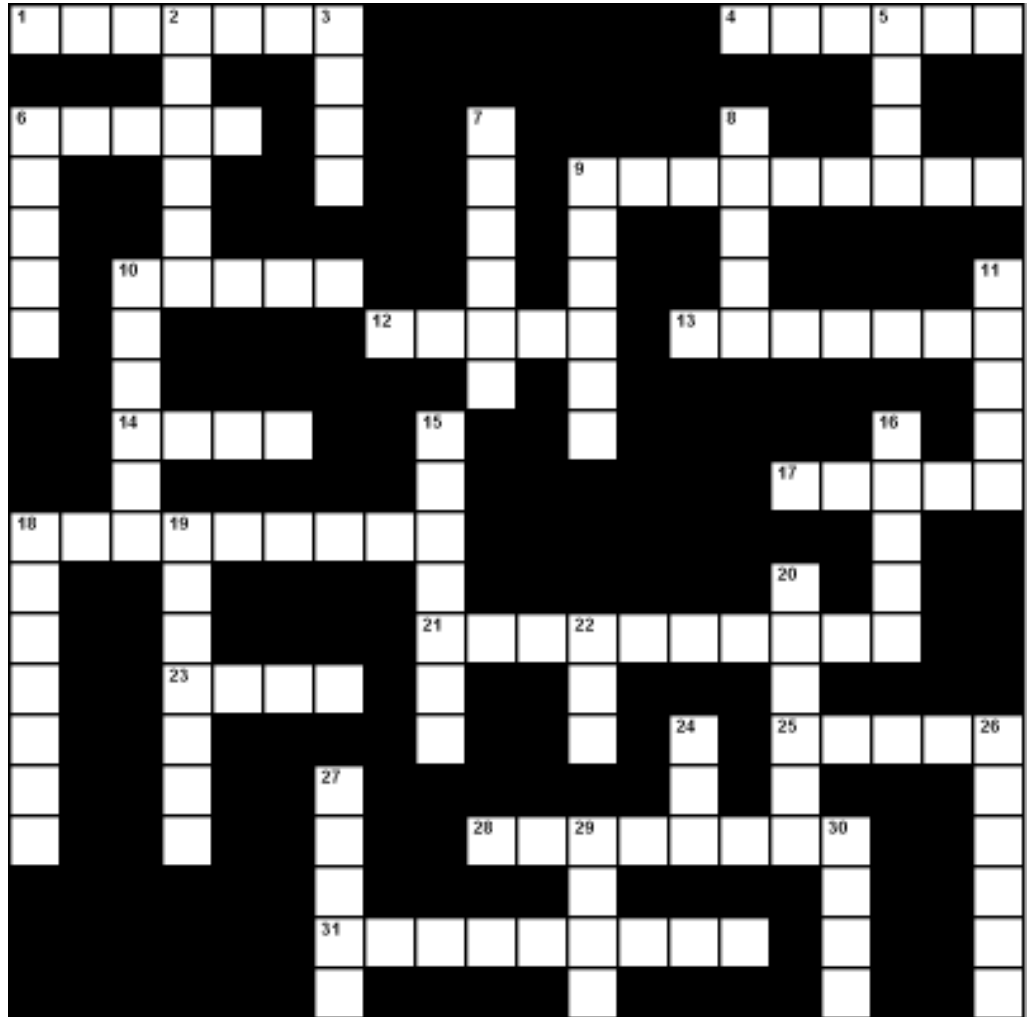
