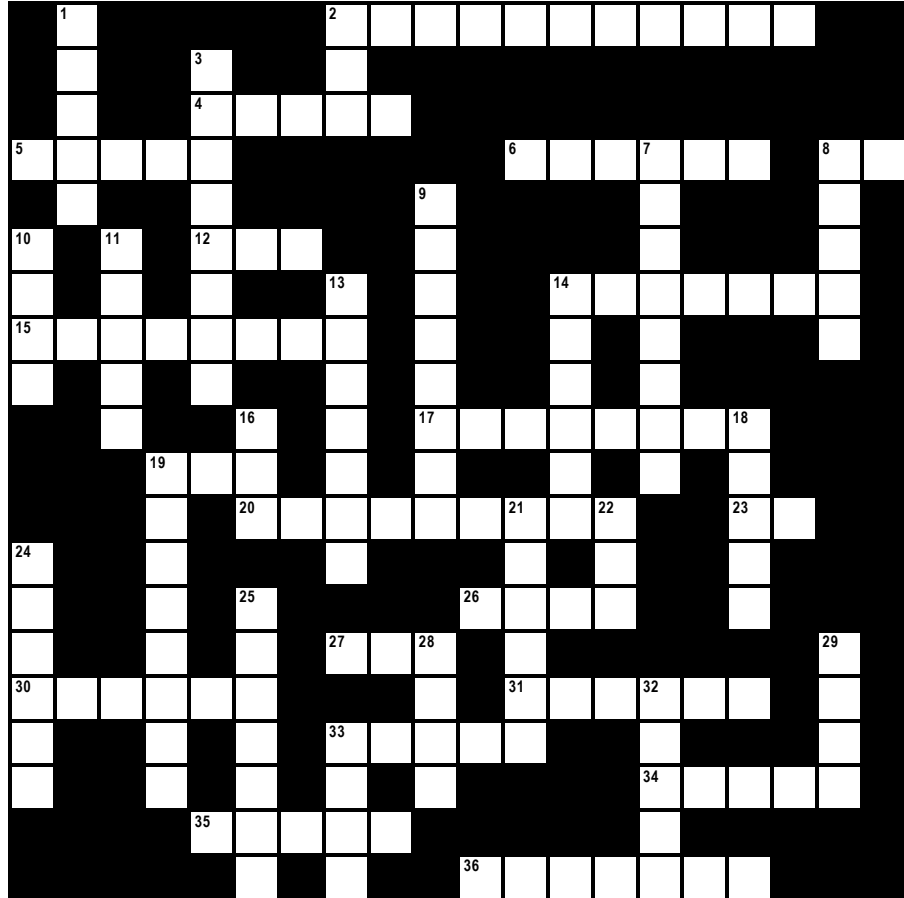


B31a Upon You I Build My Church, Matthew 16:13-19, Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles
