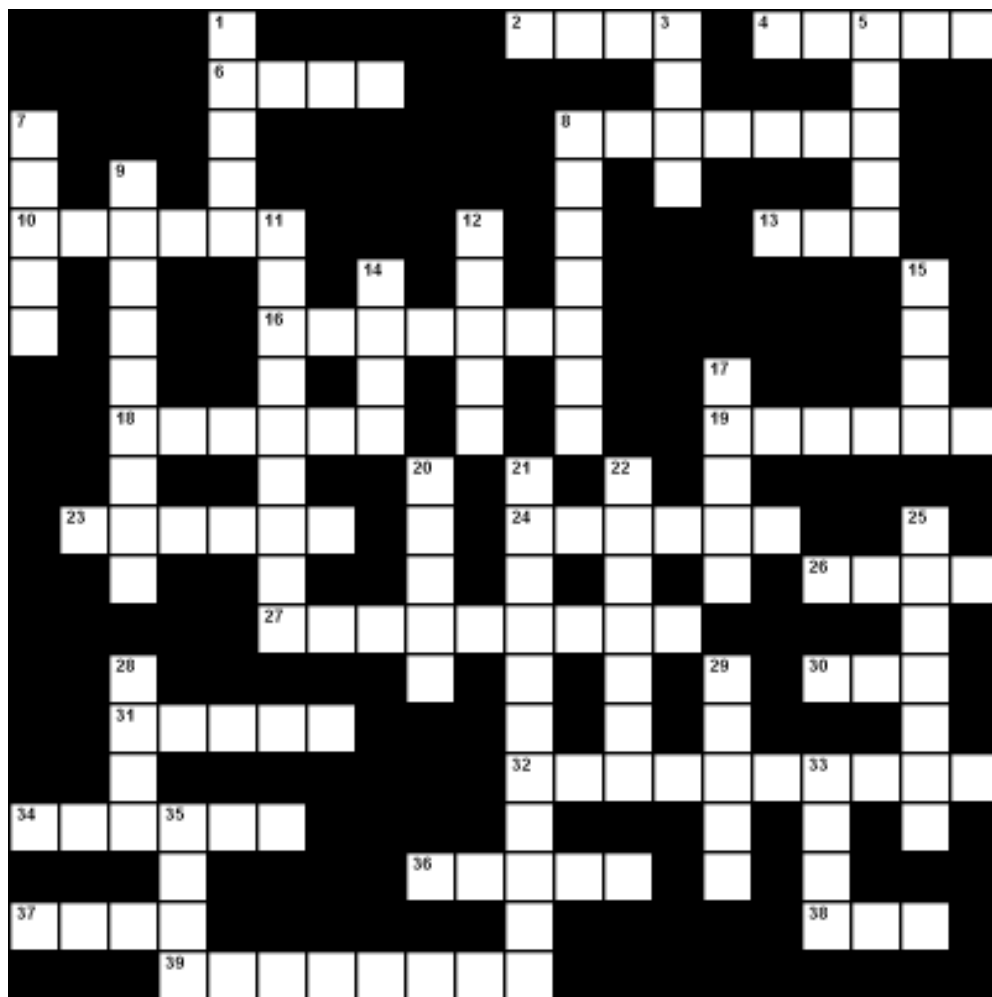


B32 Hometown Faith, Mark 6:1-6, Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
