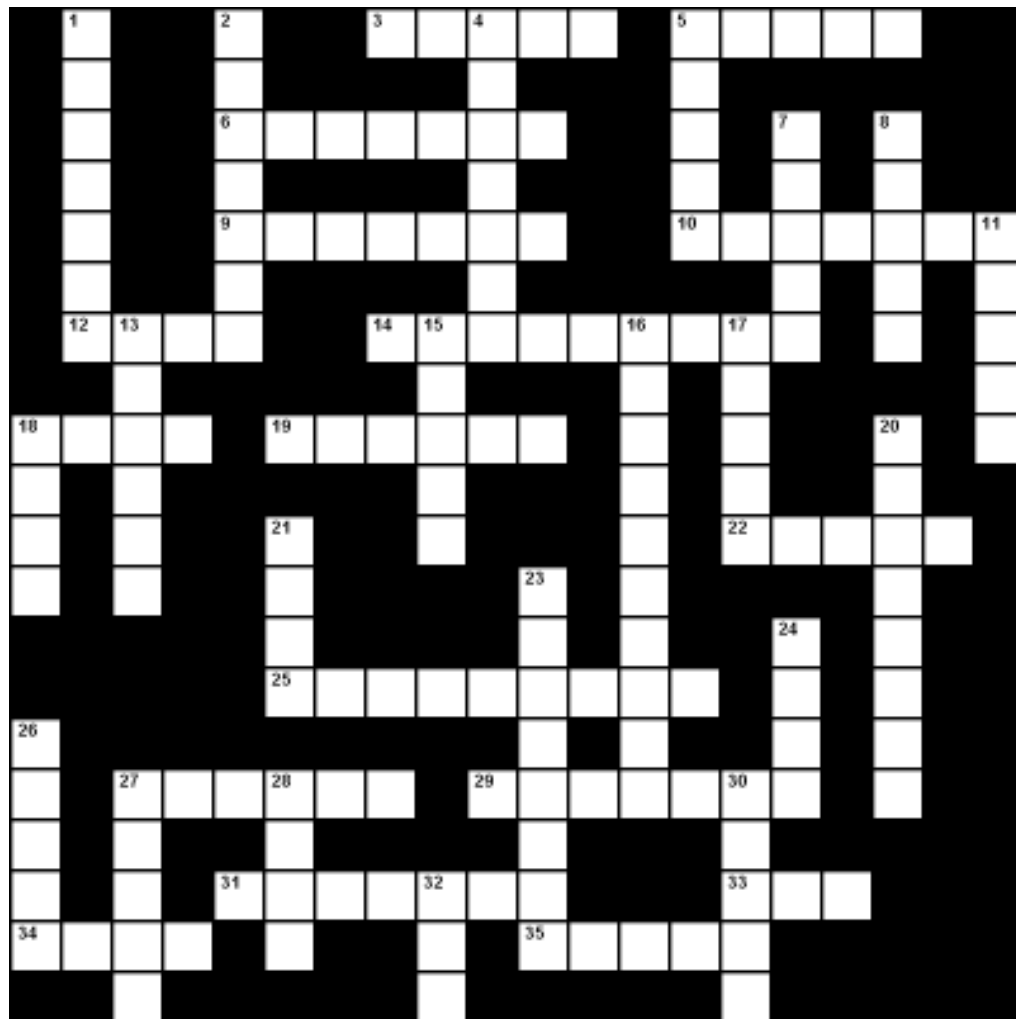


B33 Take Nothing but a Walking Stick, Mark 6:7-13, Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
