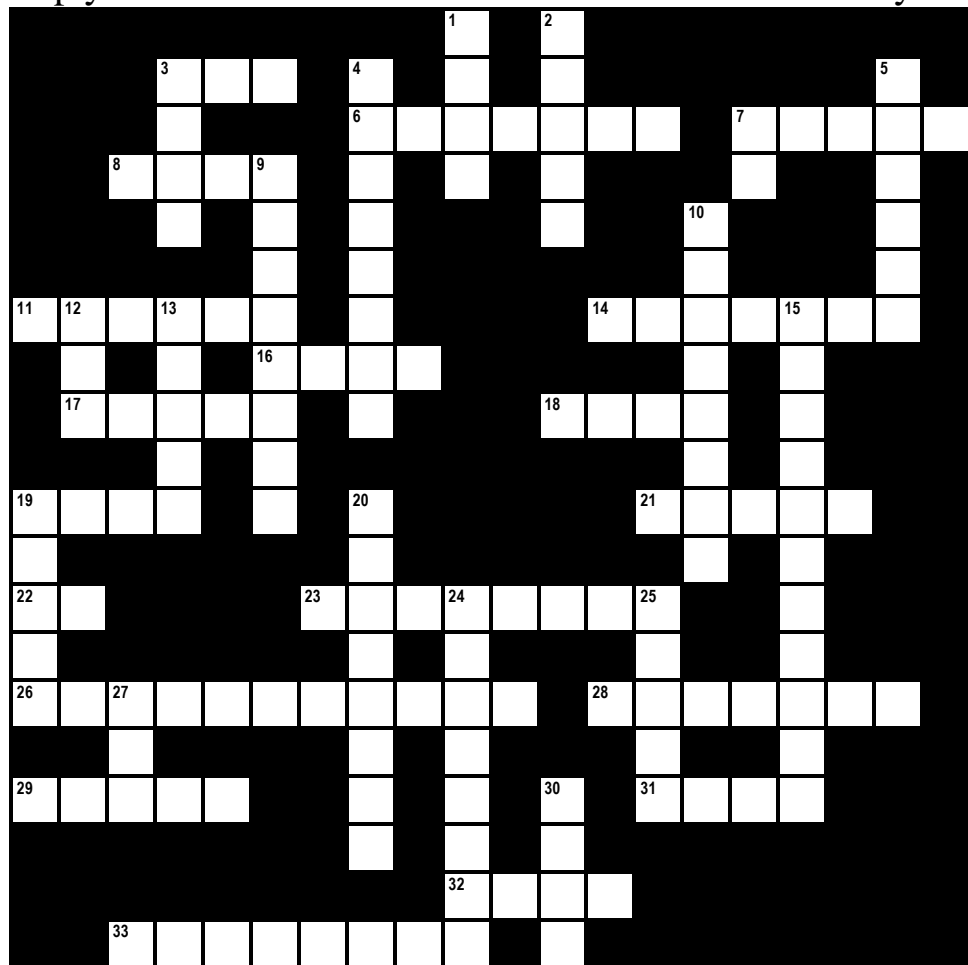


**B34 Sheep without a Shepherd, Mark 6:30-34,
