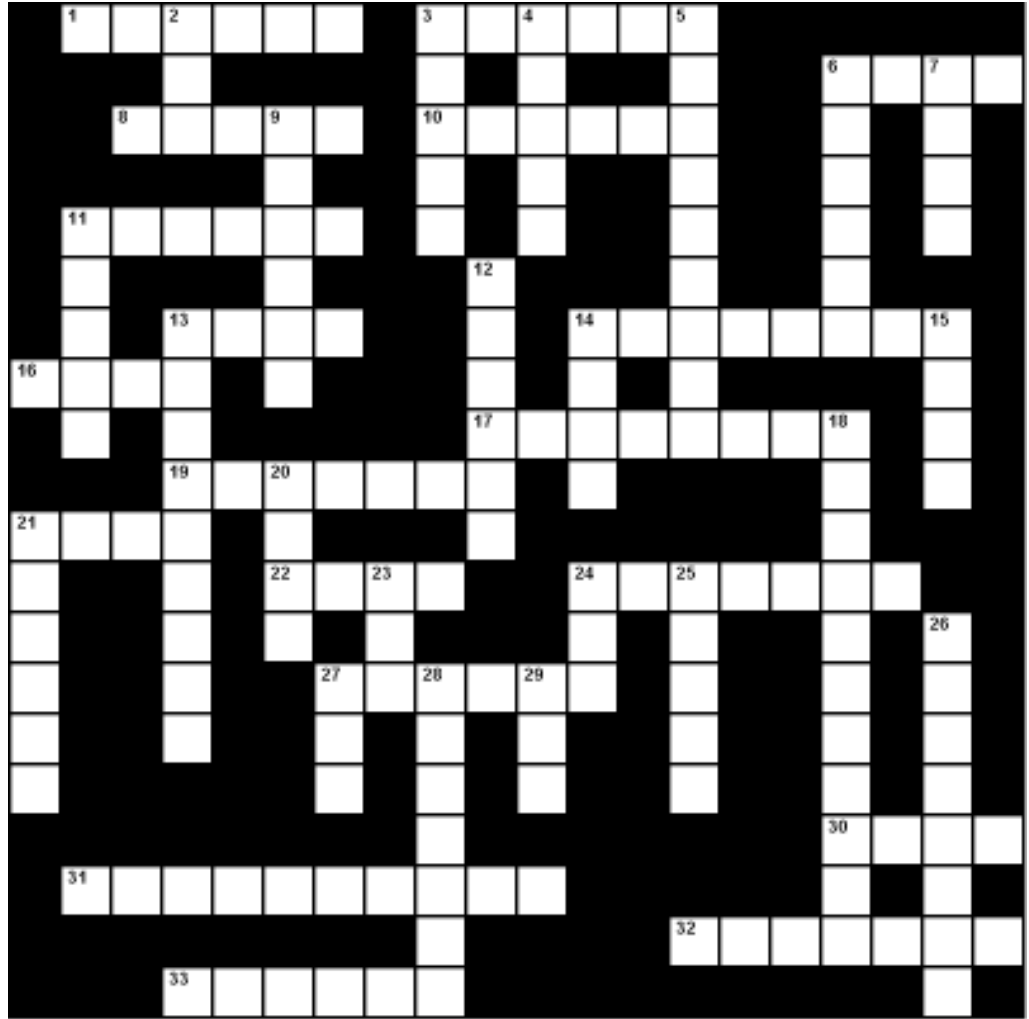


## B35 Five Loaves and Two Fish, John 6:1-15, Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
