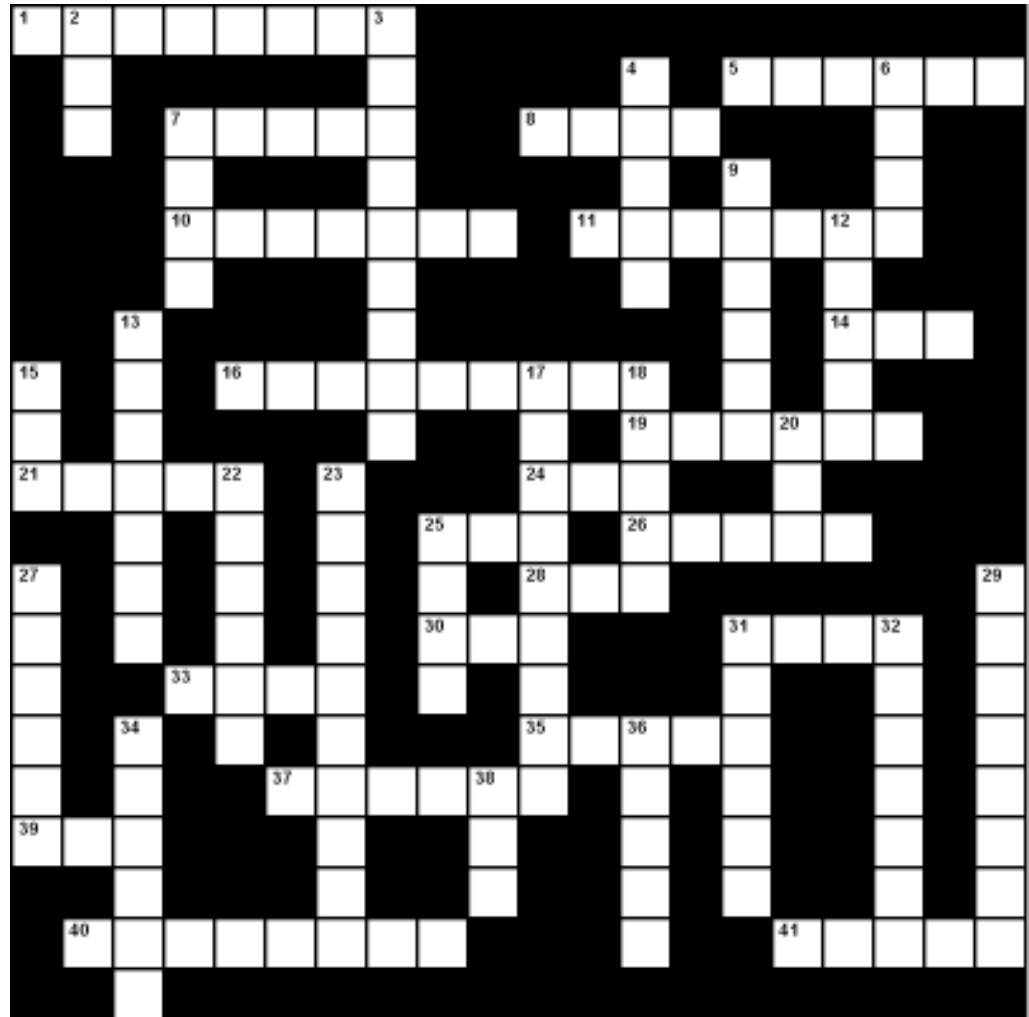


**B36 I Am the Bread of Life, John 6:24-35,
