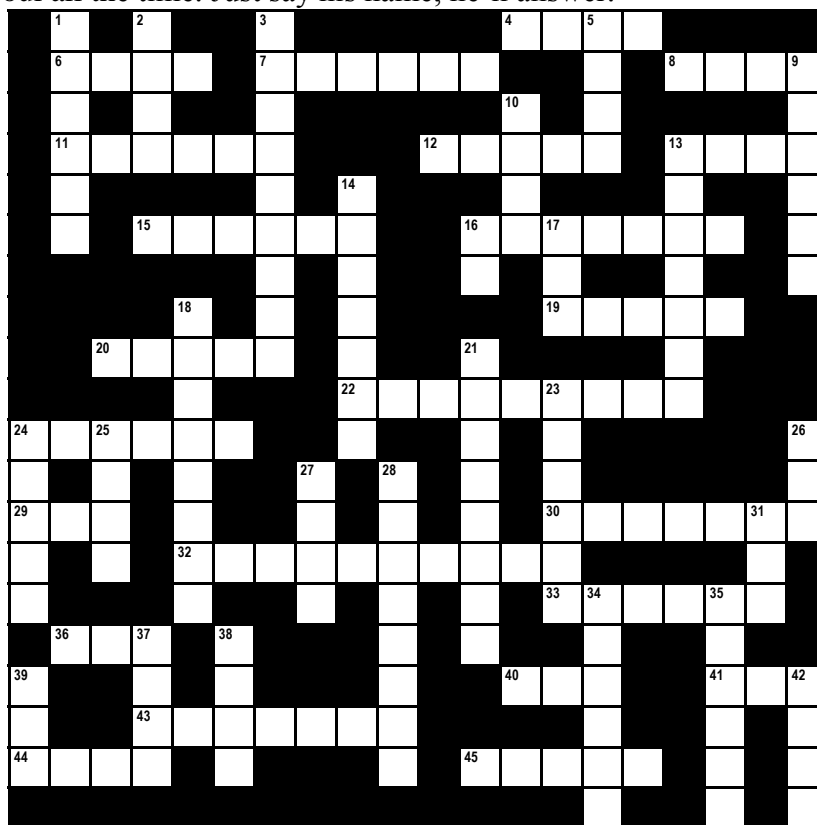


B38 I Am the Living Bread, John 6:51-58, Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time
