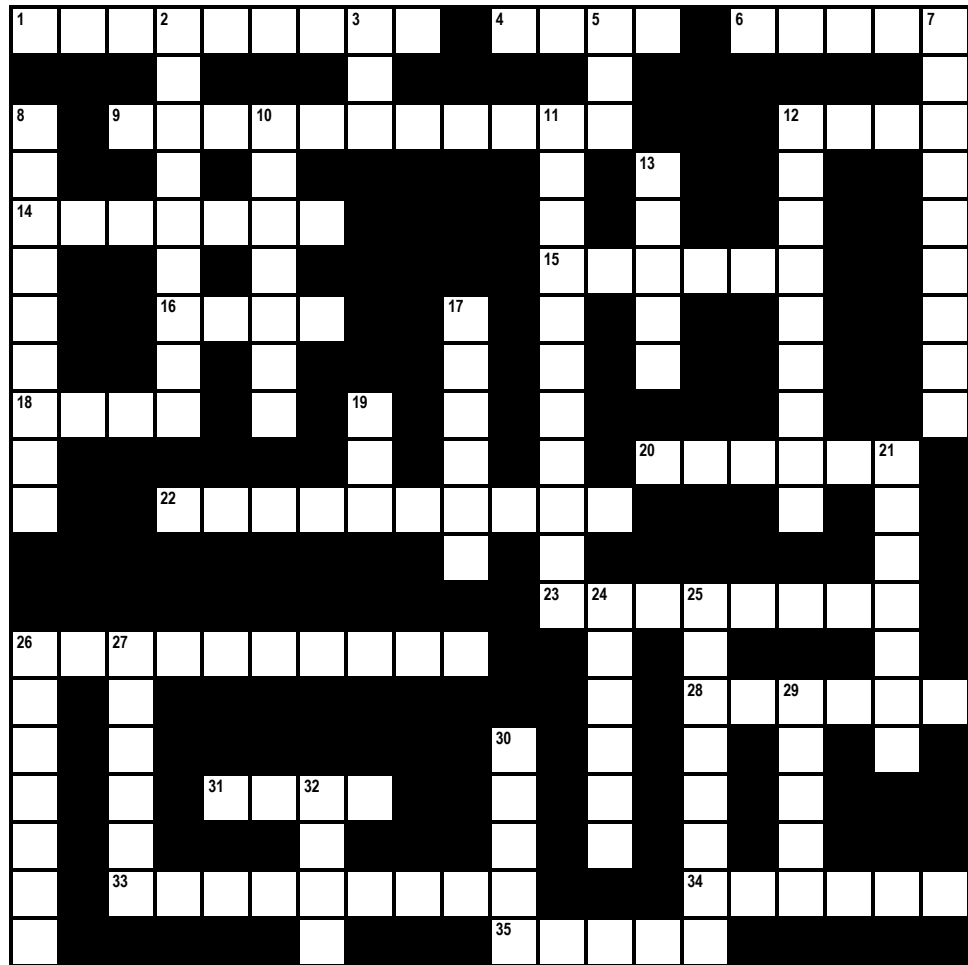


B40 Good or Evil Comes from the Heart, Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23, Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time
