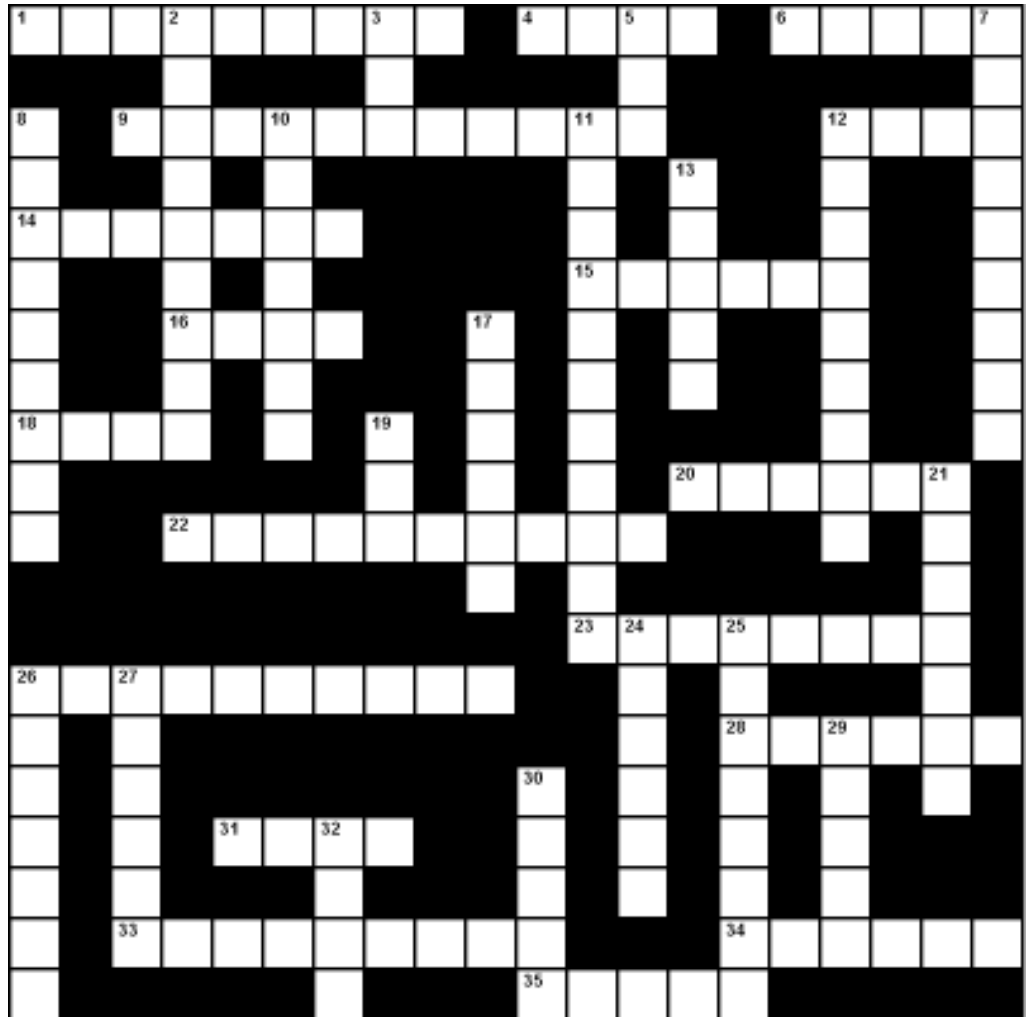


**B40 Good or Evil, Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23,
