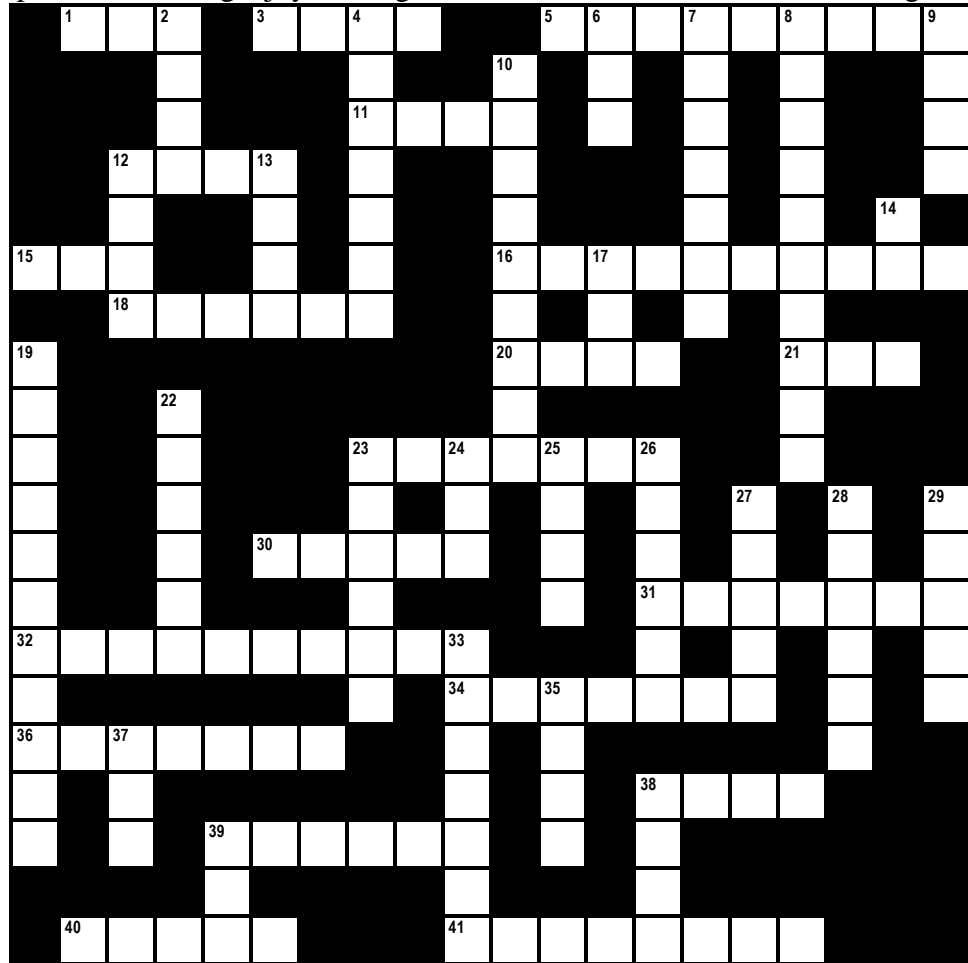


B41 Jesus Heals the Deaf and Mute, Mark 7:31-37, Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time
