

B42 Take Up Your Cross, Mark 8:27-35, Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

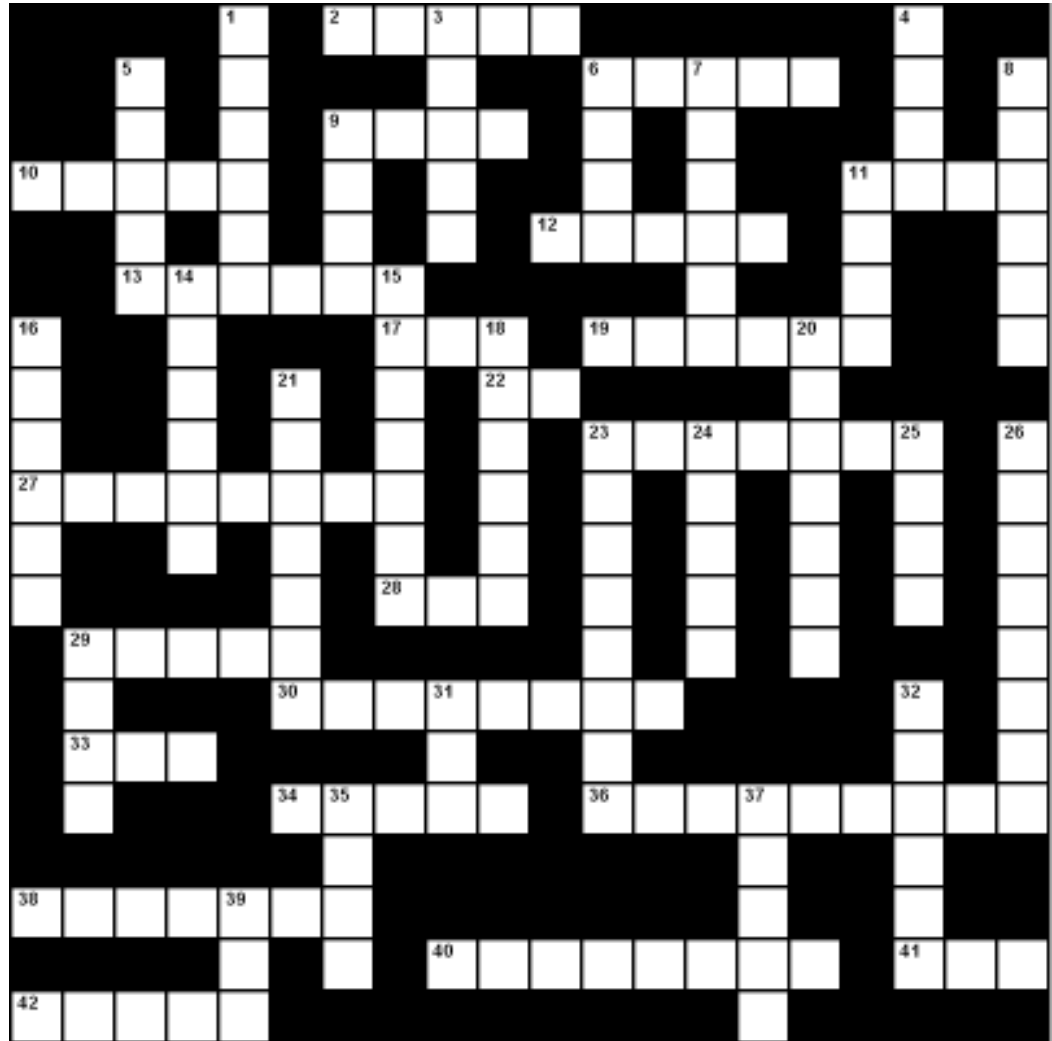
