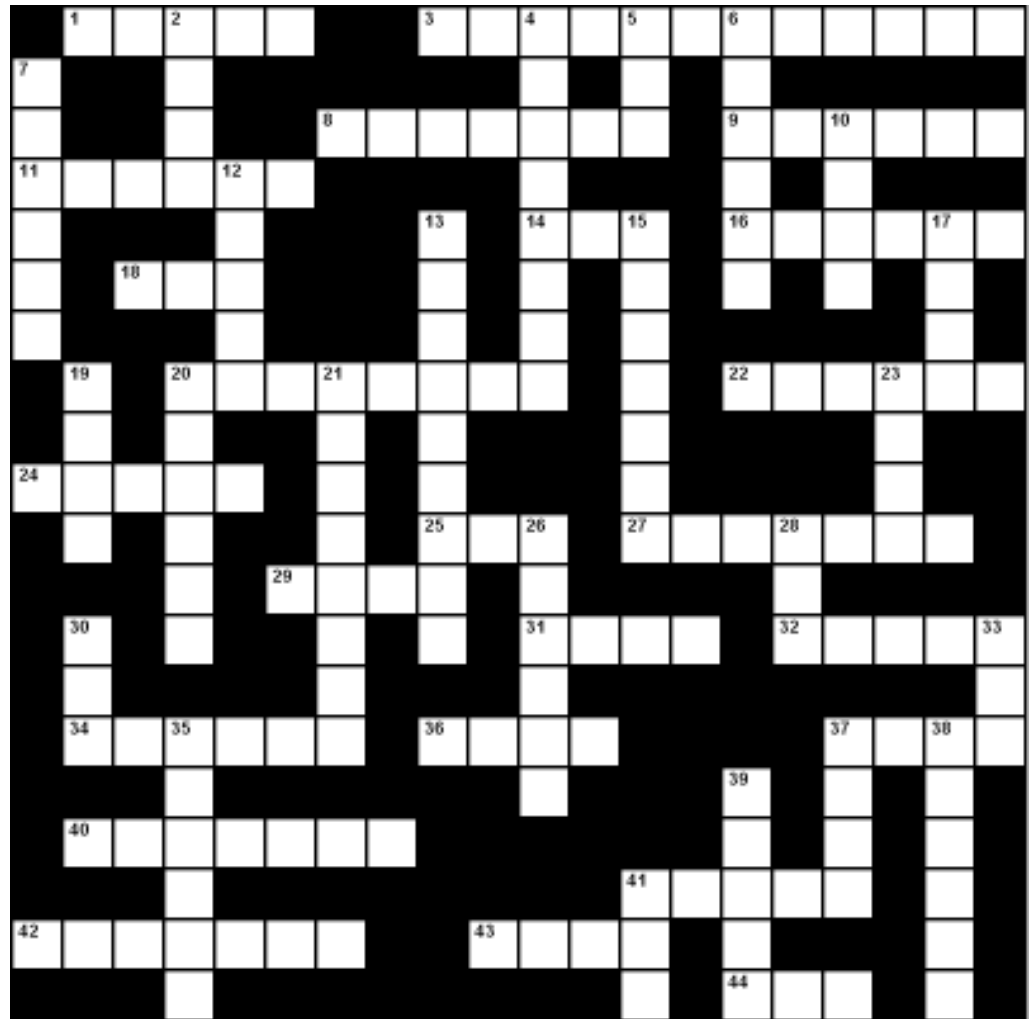


**B43 Fire Never Stops Burning in Gehenna, Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48,
