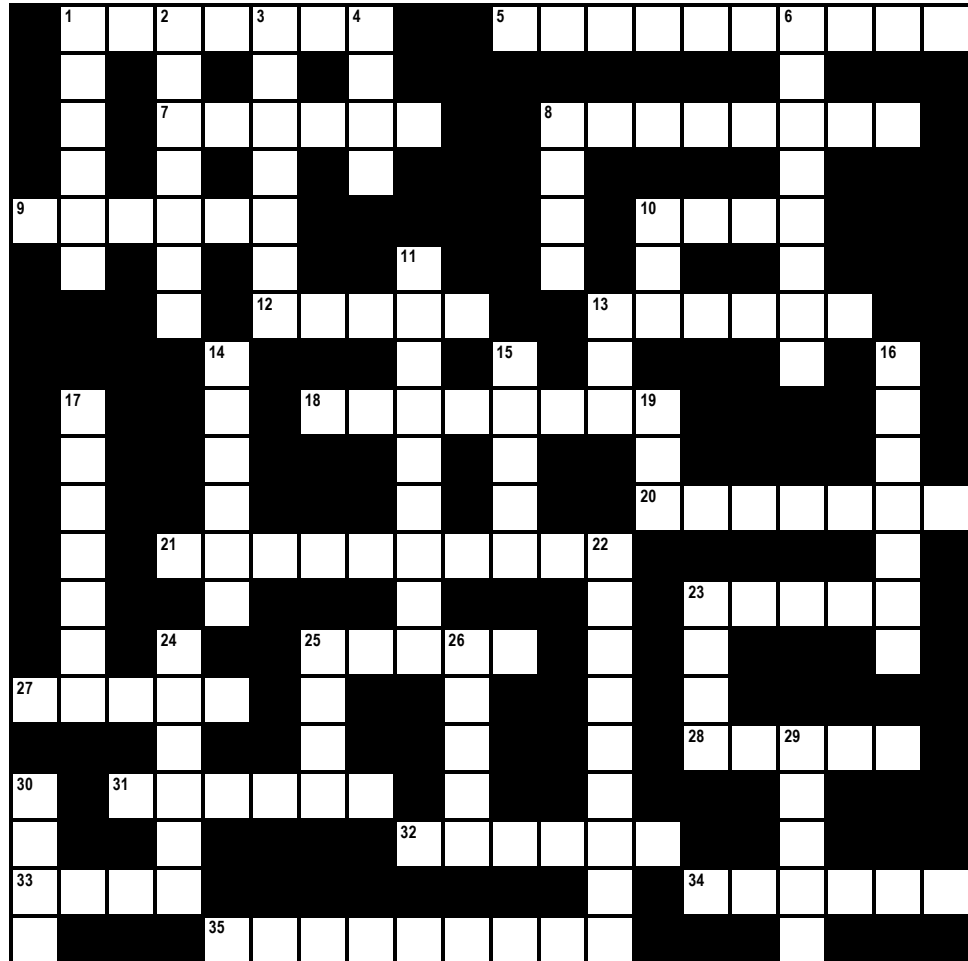


**B45 Let Children Come to Me, Mark 10:2-16,
