

B46 Sell What You Have, Mark 10:17-30, Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

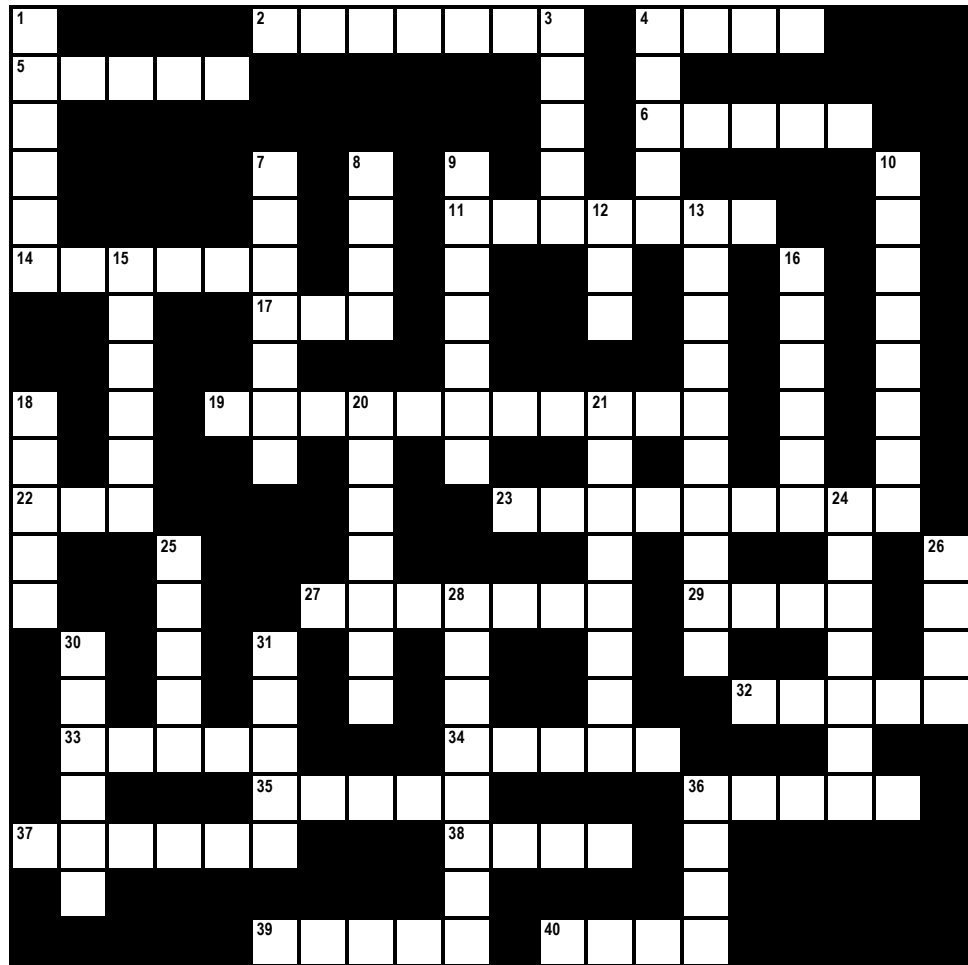
