

B48 I Want to See, Mark 10:46-52, Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

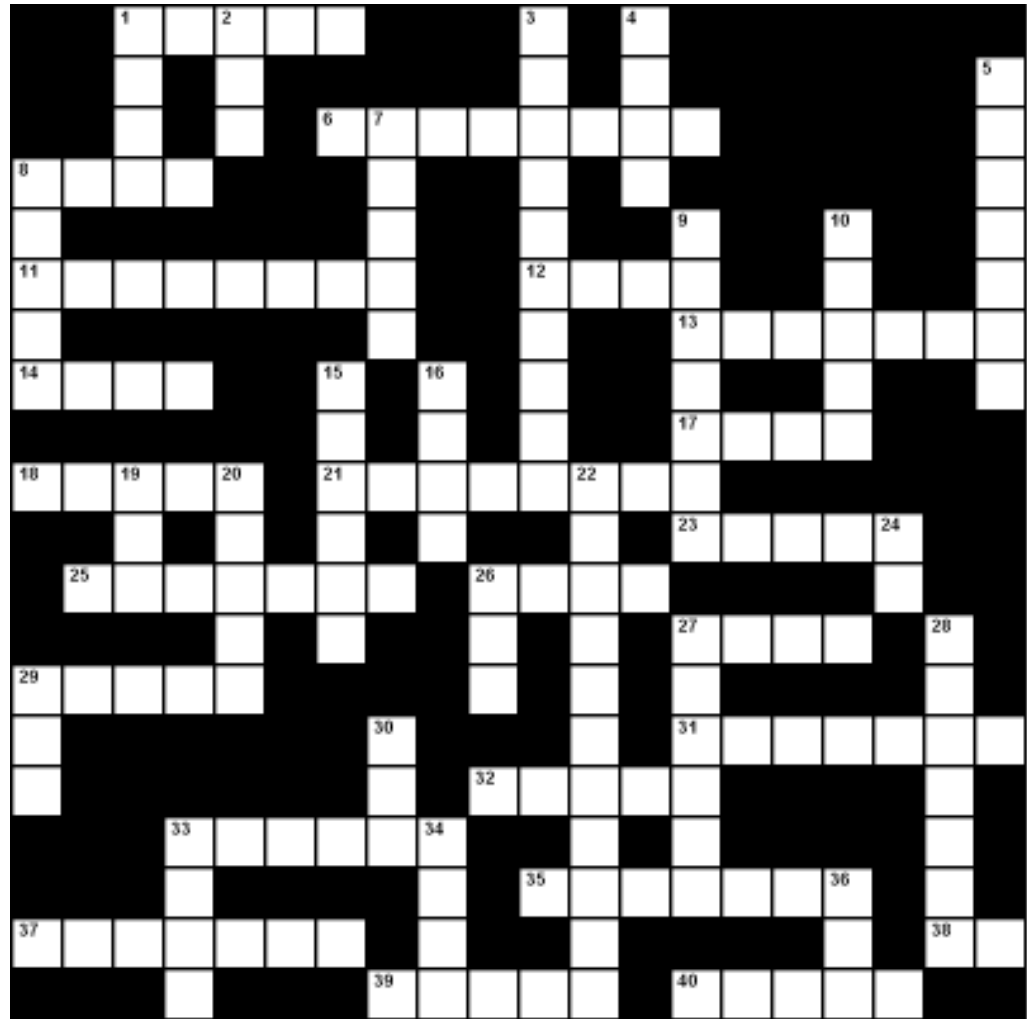
