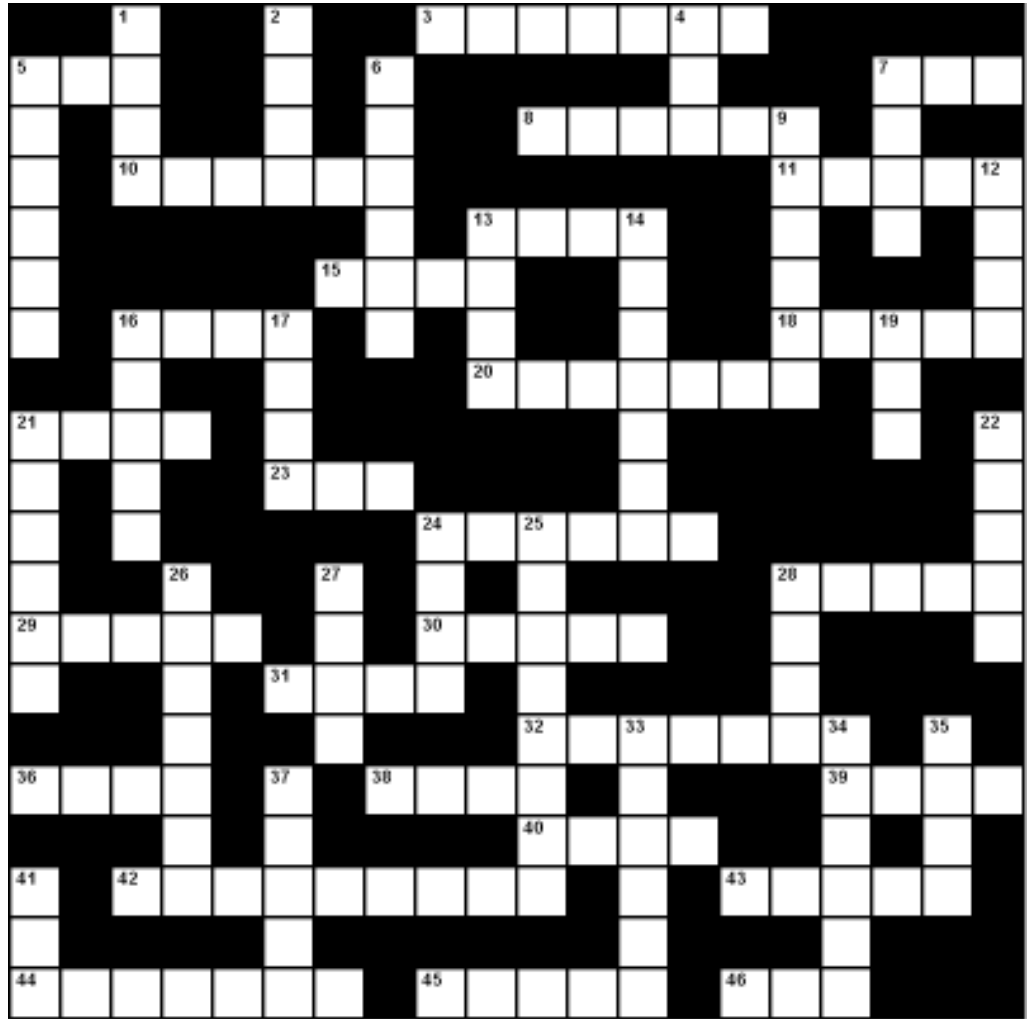


## B49a Lazarus, Come Out, Mark 9:30-37, Feast of All Saints
