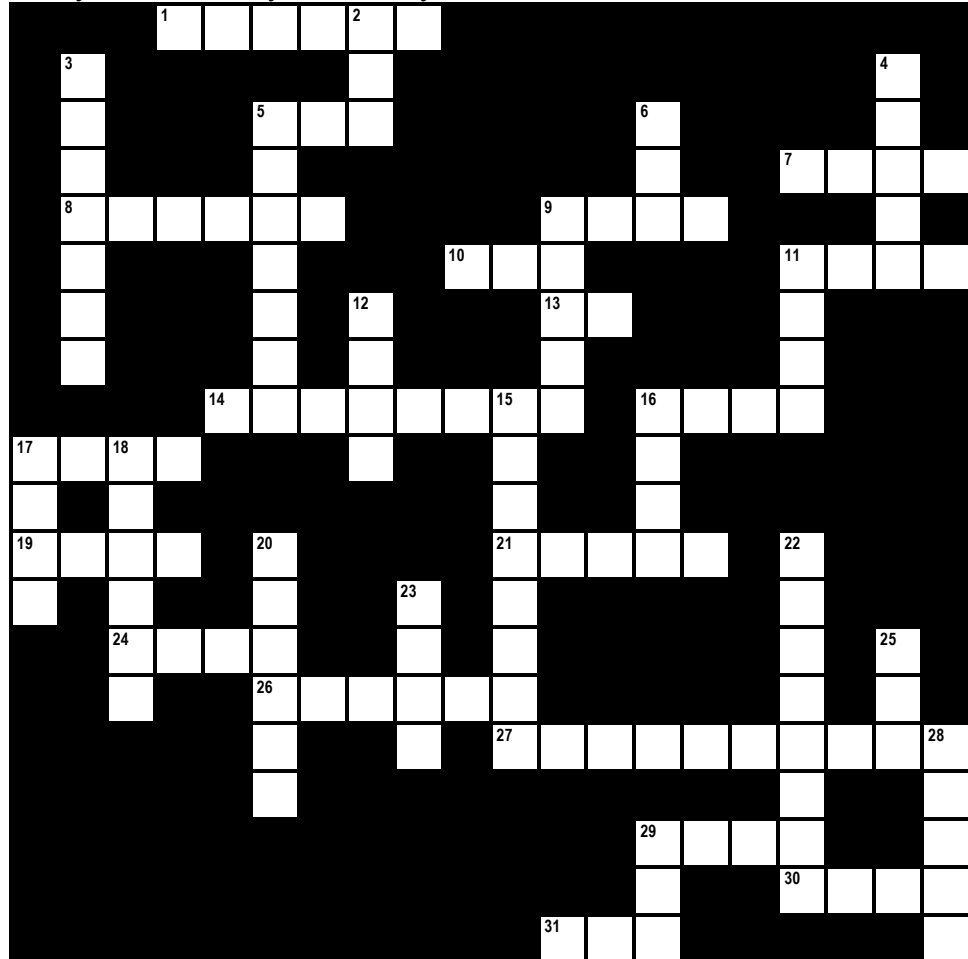


**B49b I Will Not Reject You, John 6:37-40,
